




## Catholic Population of Archdiocese

#### As Part of Total Population






## Total Population Change By Major Areas of Archdiocese



### Percent Change in Total Population Groups-Area of Archdiocese



## Change in Total Percent of Population-Total Archdiocese








## Racial/Ethnic Background of Diocesan Priests







## Racial/Ethnic Background of Diocesan Priests by Age Grouping



## Birthplace of Diocesan Priests by Age Grouping


















## **Total Number of Religious Brothers**









## Racial/Ethnic Background of Deacons- Current





















### Change from 1985 to 2023






# Number of Elementary Schools in Archdiocese




# Number of Secondary Schools in Archdiocese
