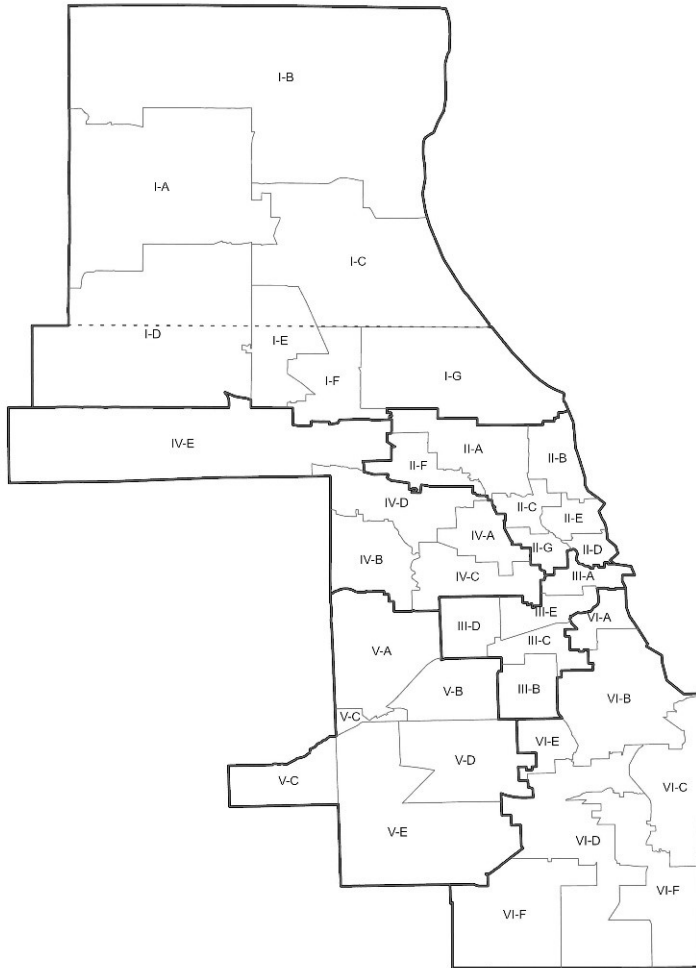

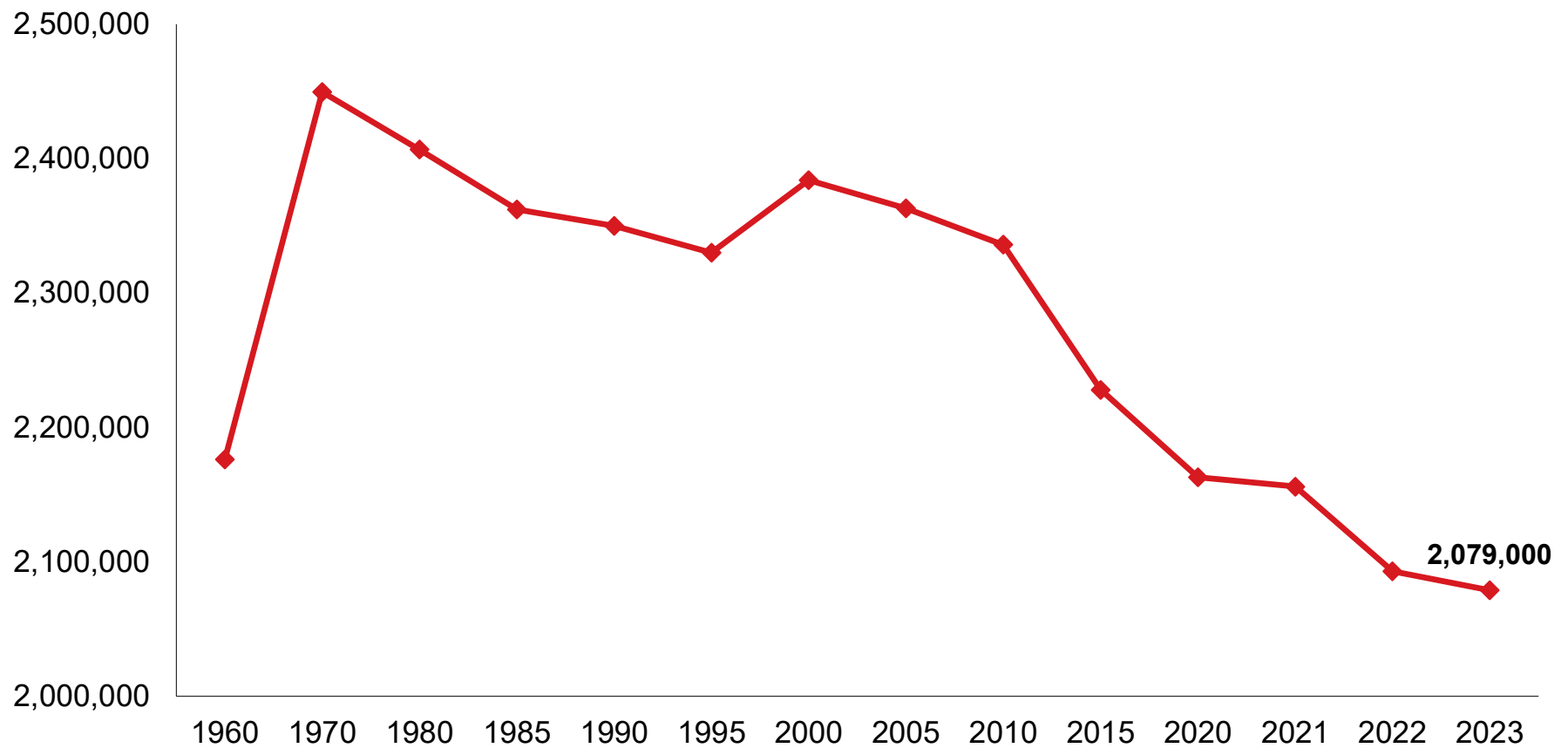

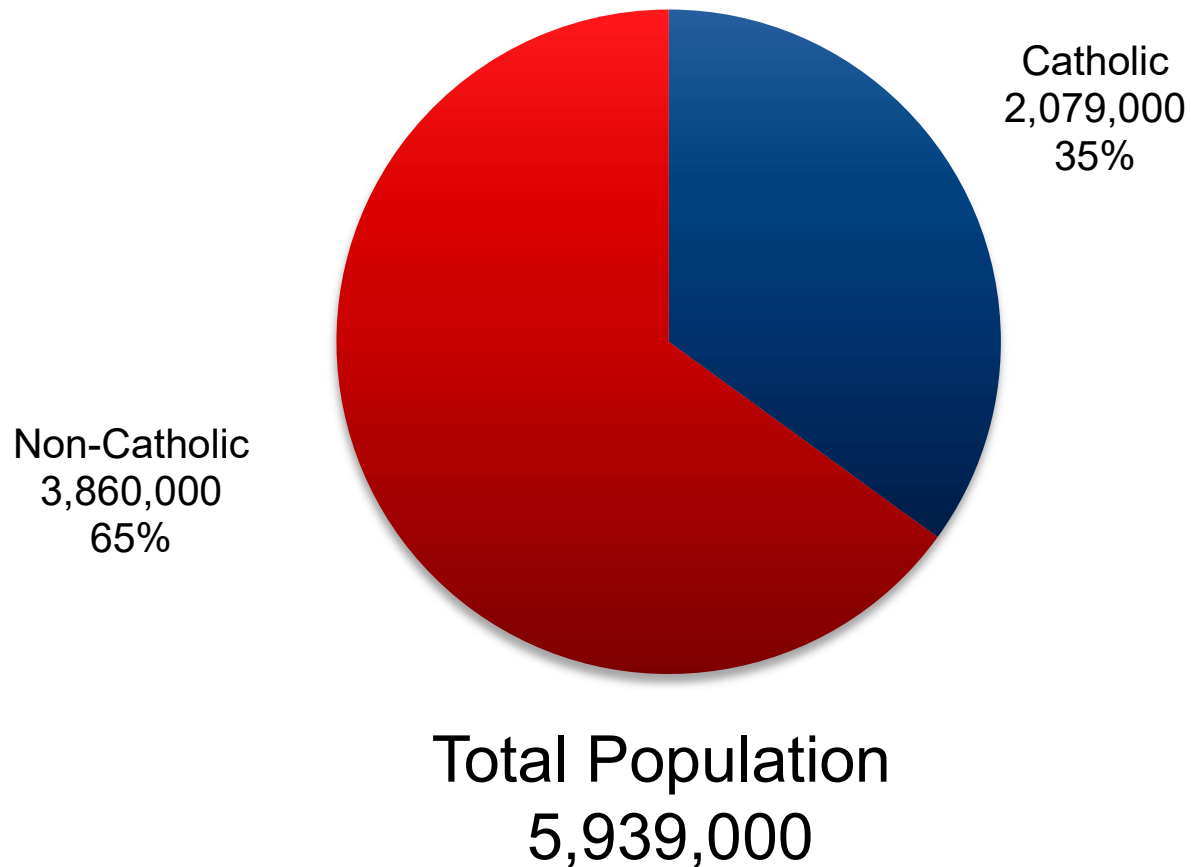

As Part of Total Population

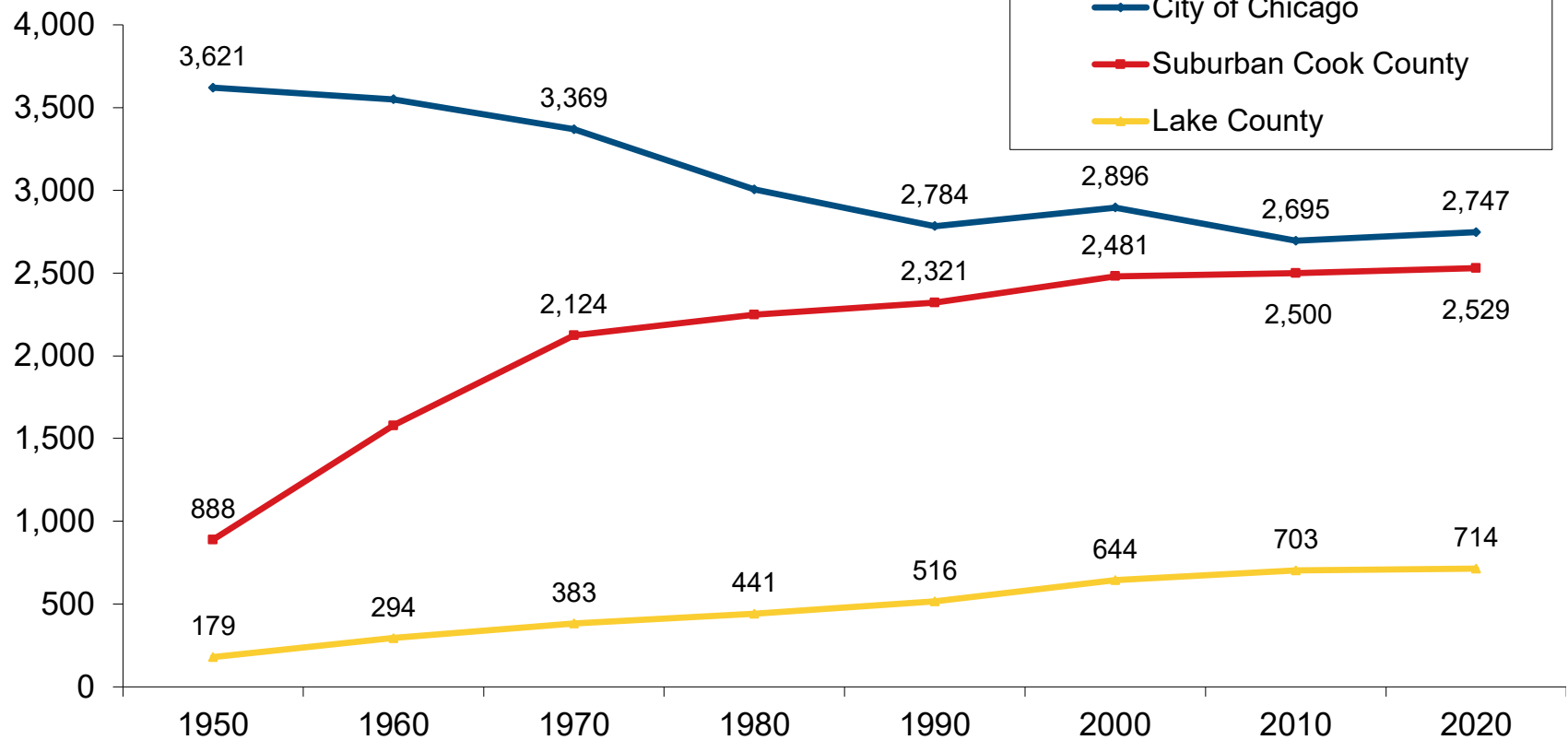




# Total Population Change By Major Areas of Archdiocese

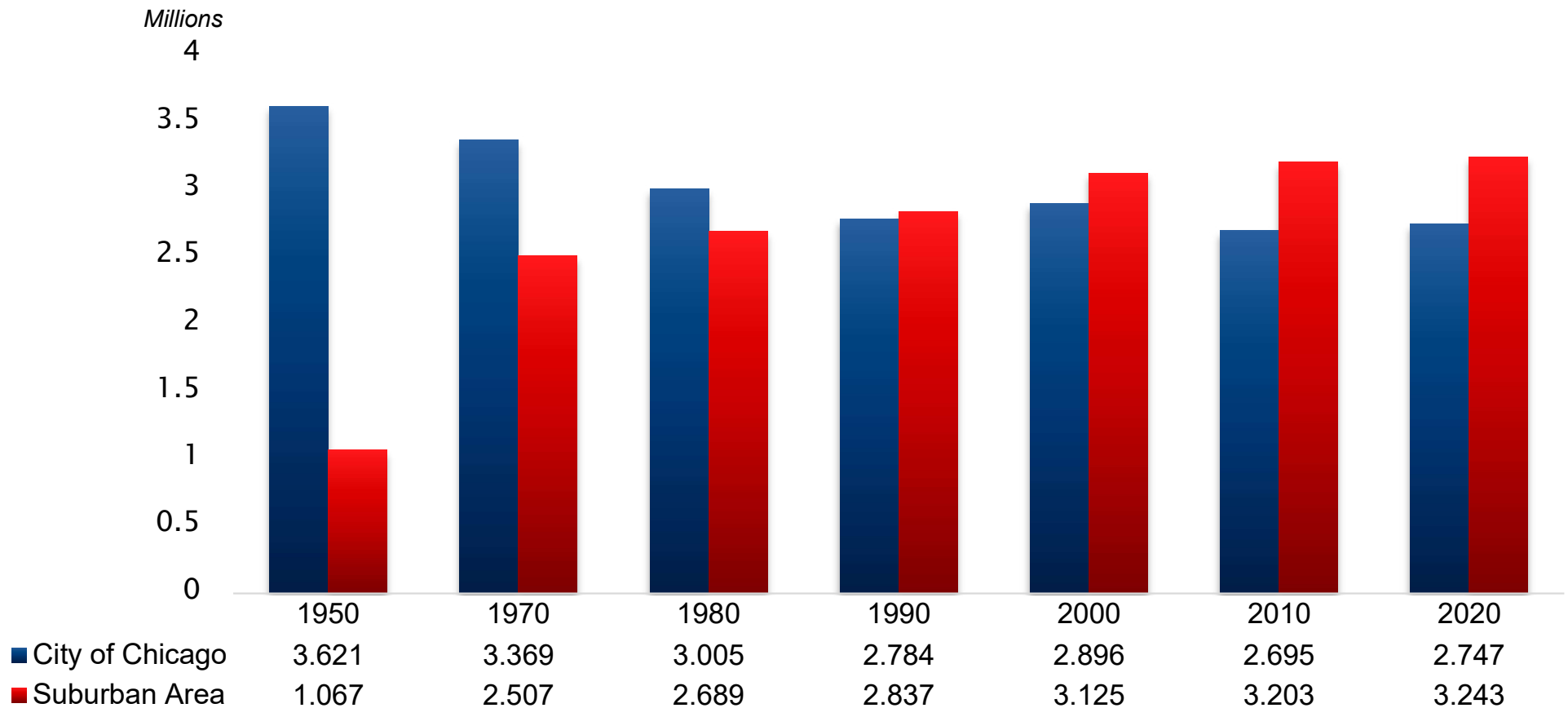

1950-2020 Census Years

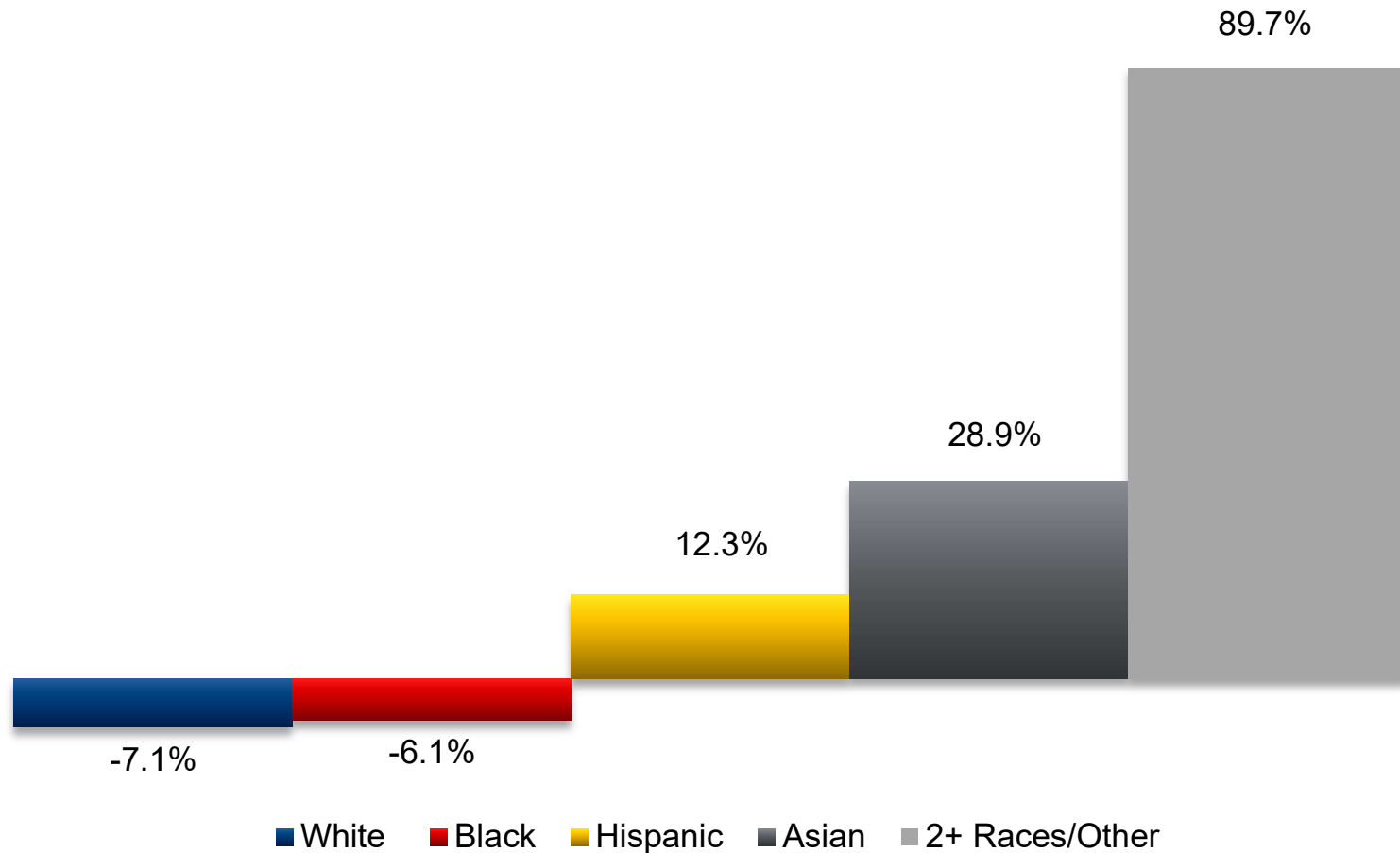

# Percent Change in Total Population Groups- Area of Archdiocese

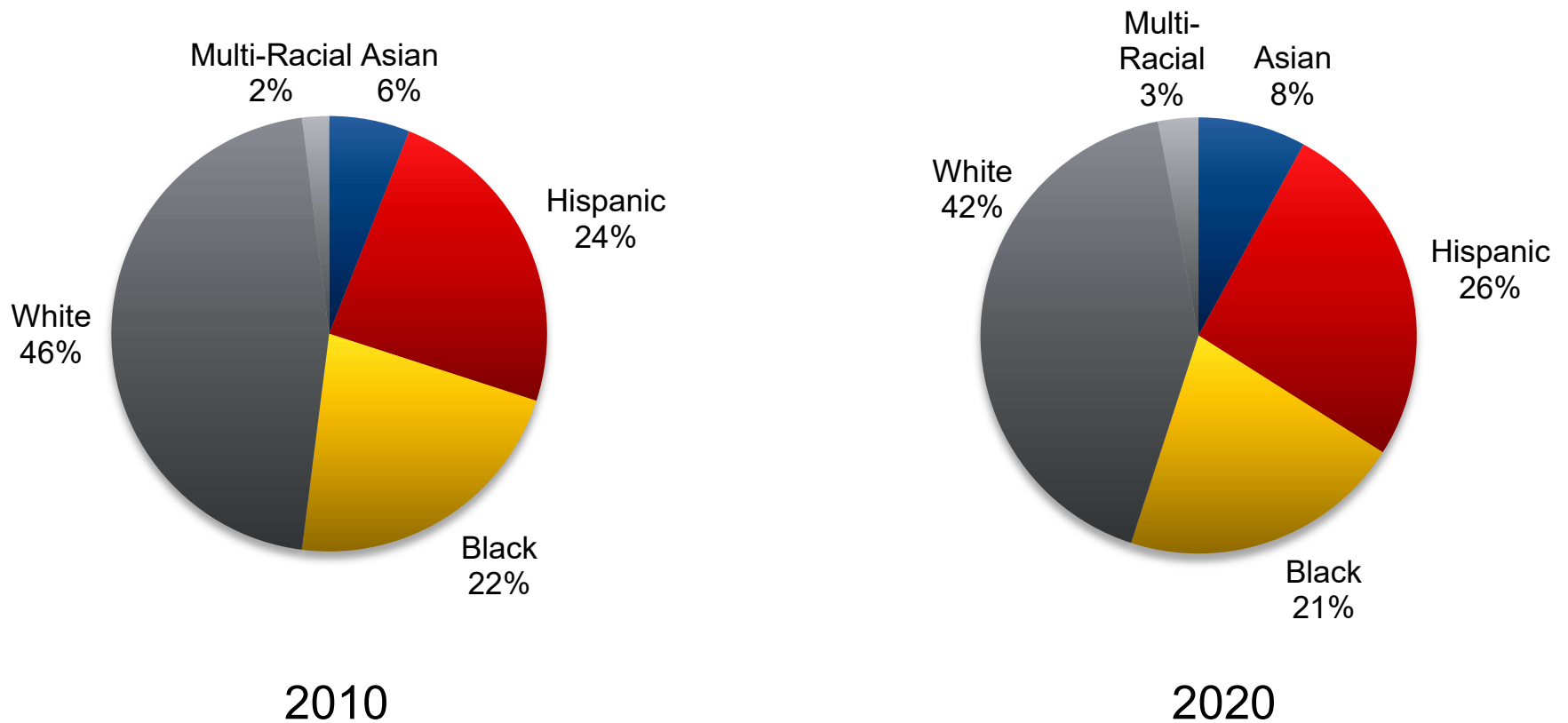
2010 to 2020 Census

# Change in Total Percent of Population- Total Archdiocese

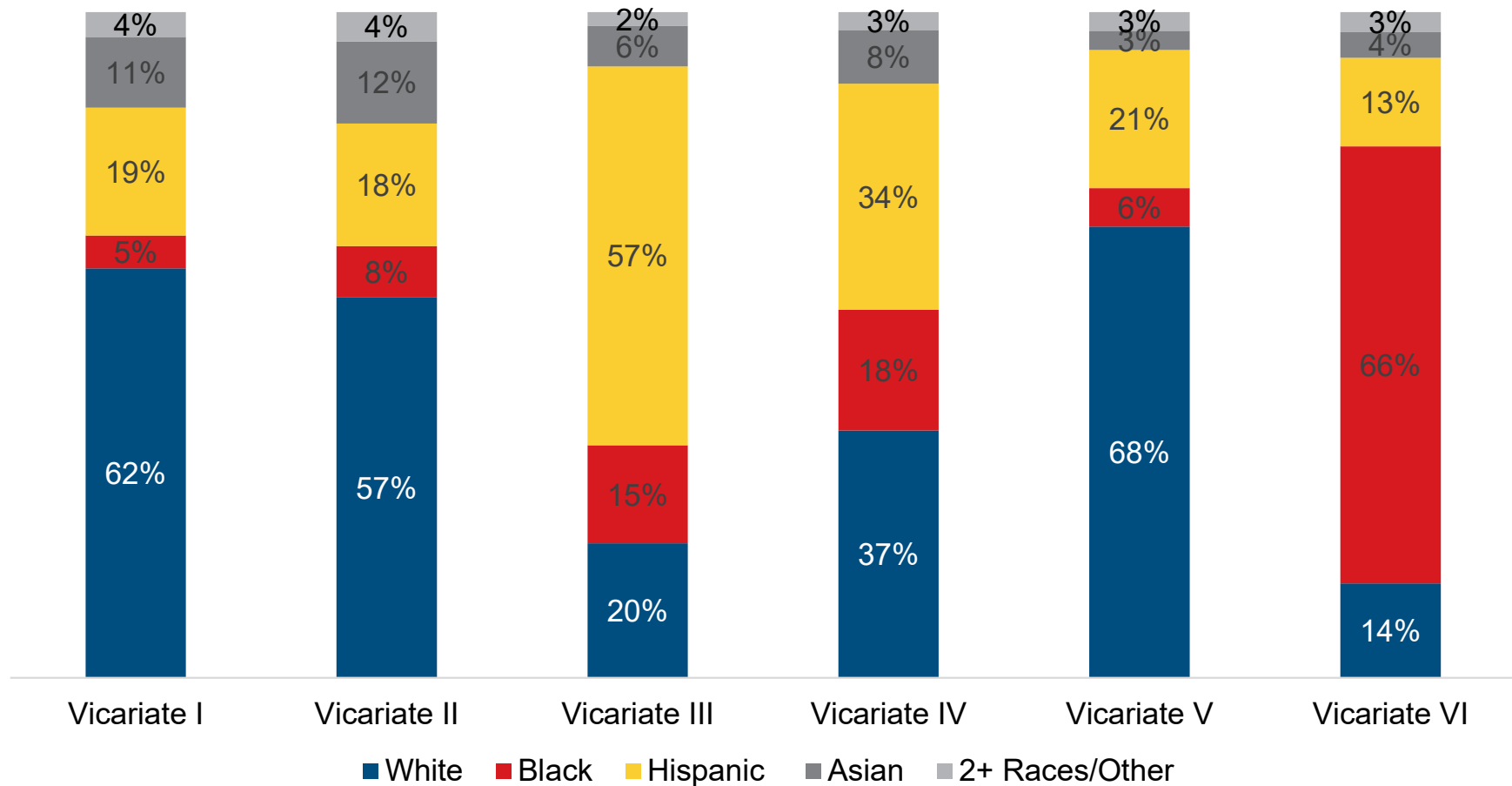

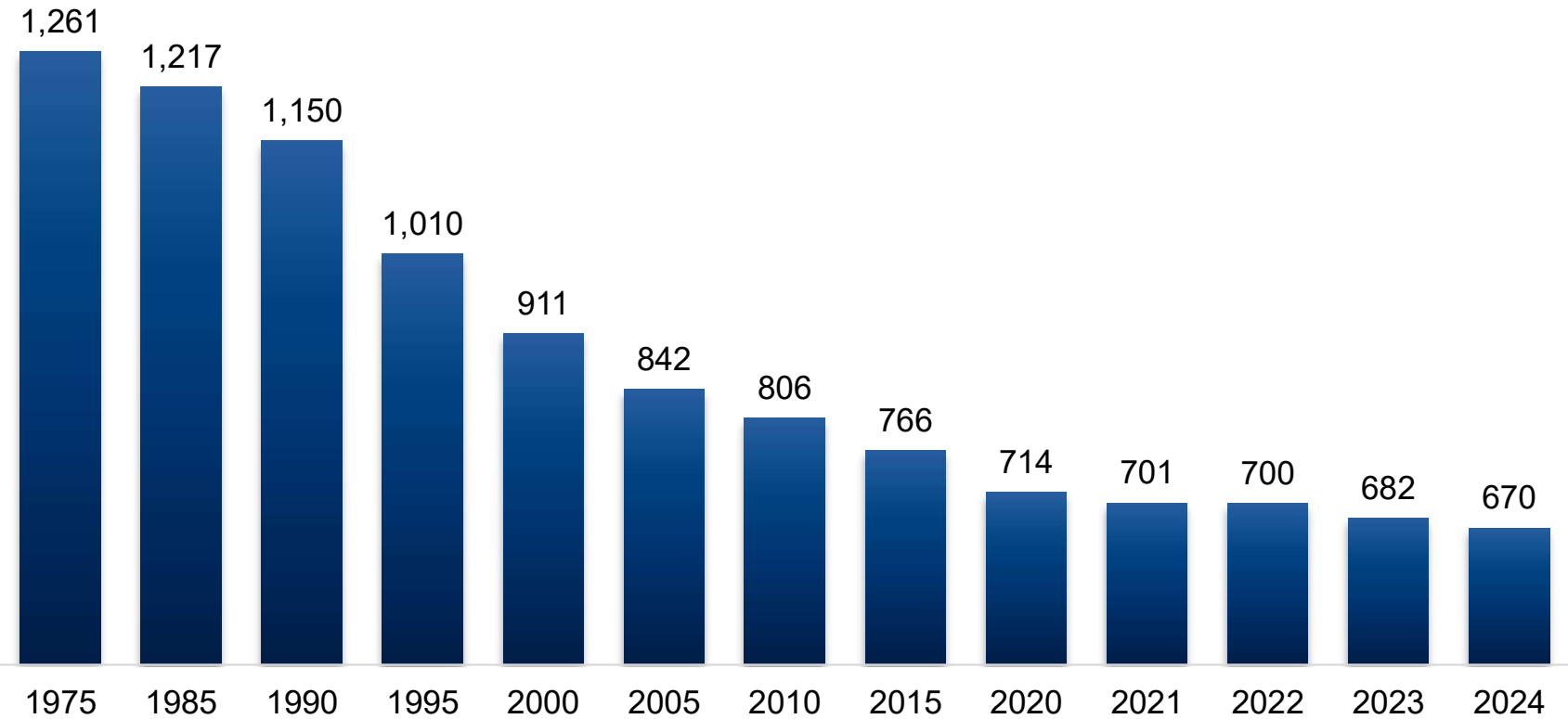


# Diocesan Priests, Deacons, Women and Men Religious, and Lay Personnel in the Archdiocese

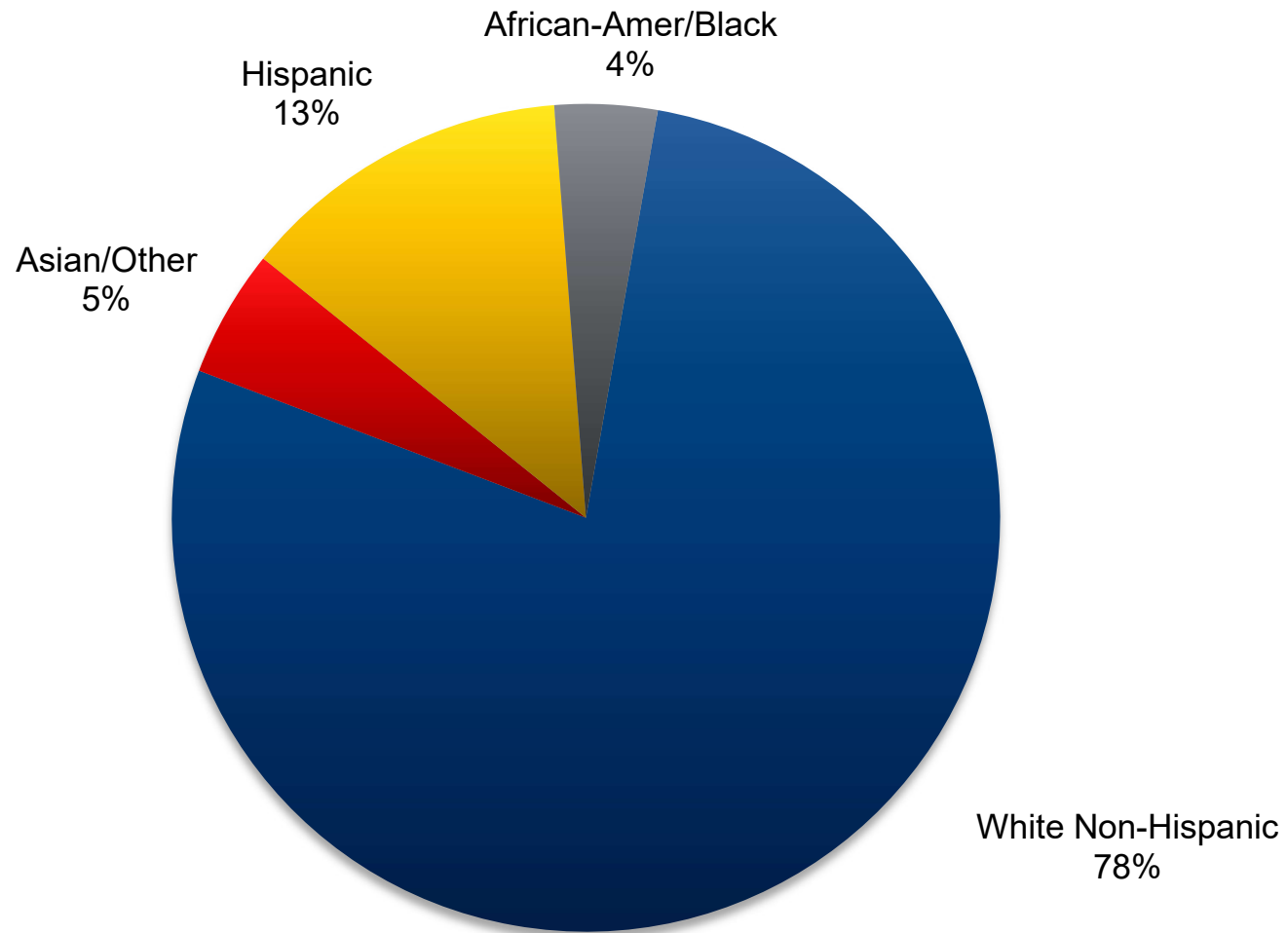

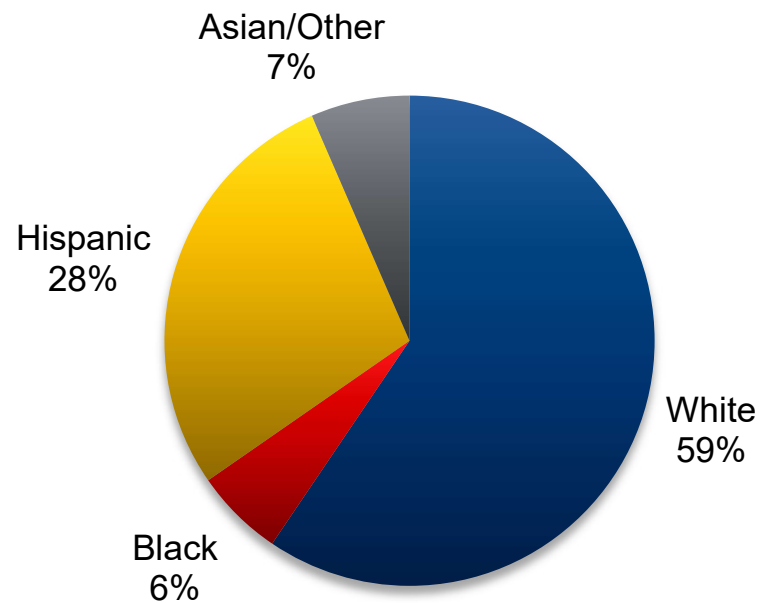
# Racial/Ethnic Background of Diocesan Priests

As of January 2024

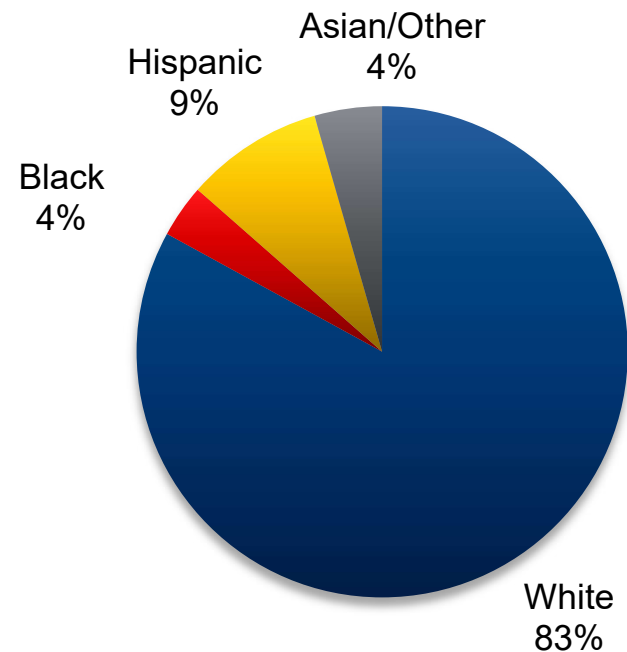


# Racial/Ethnic Background of Diocesan Priests by Age Grouping

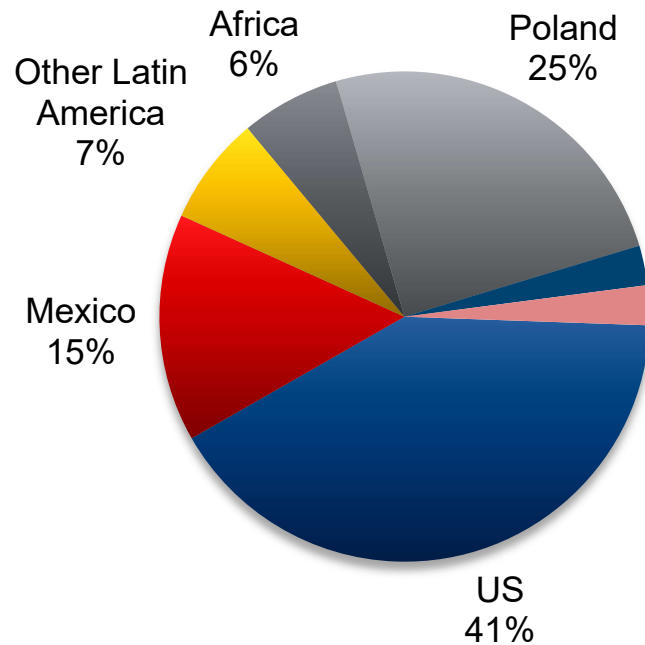

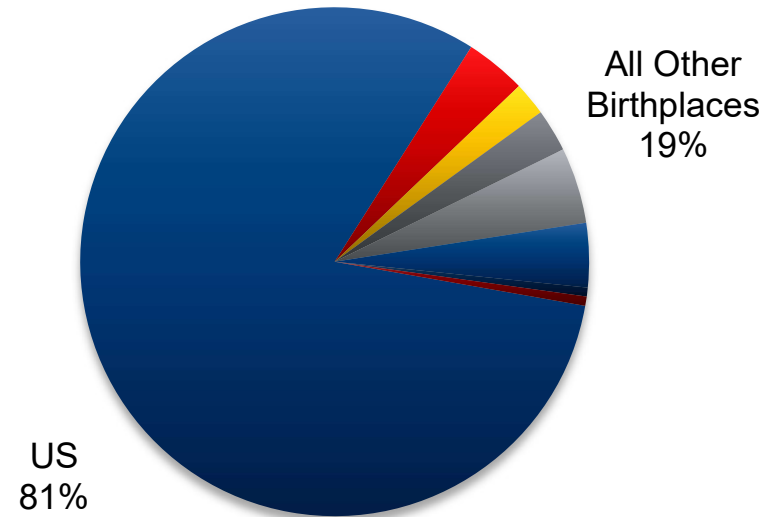
# Birthplace of Diocesan Priests by Age Grouping

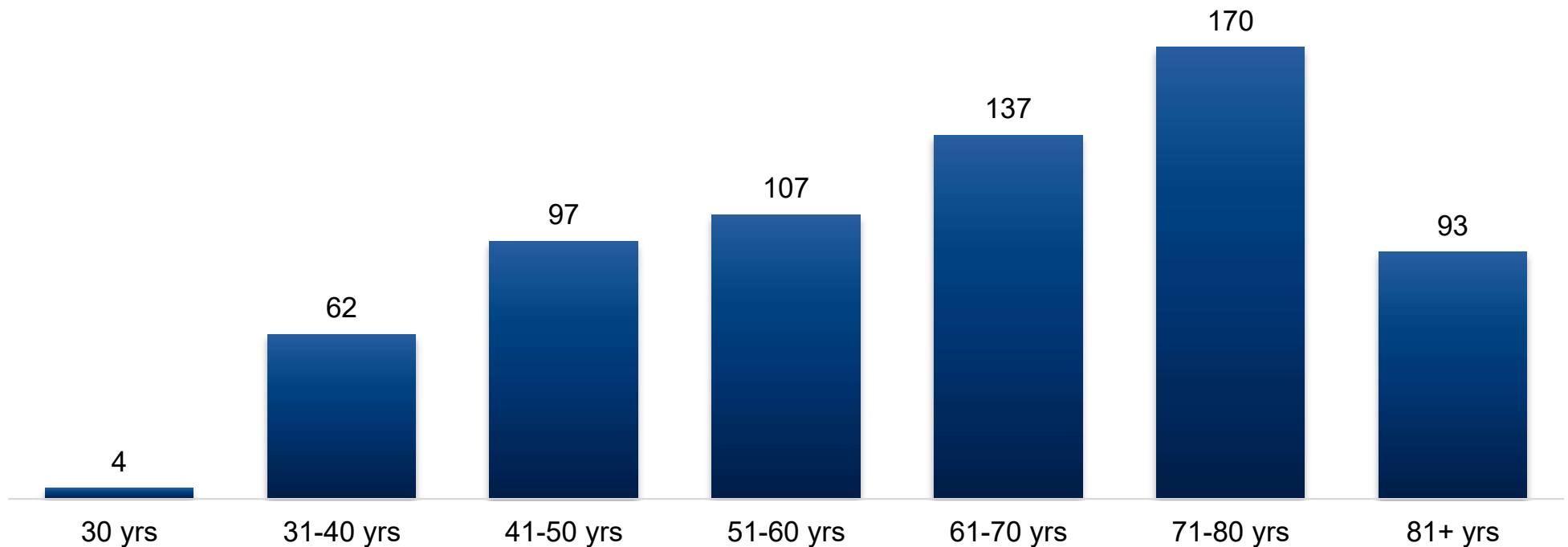

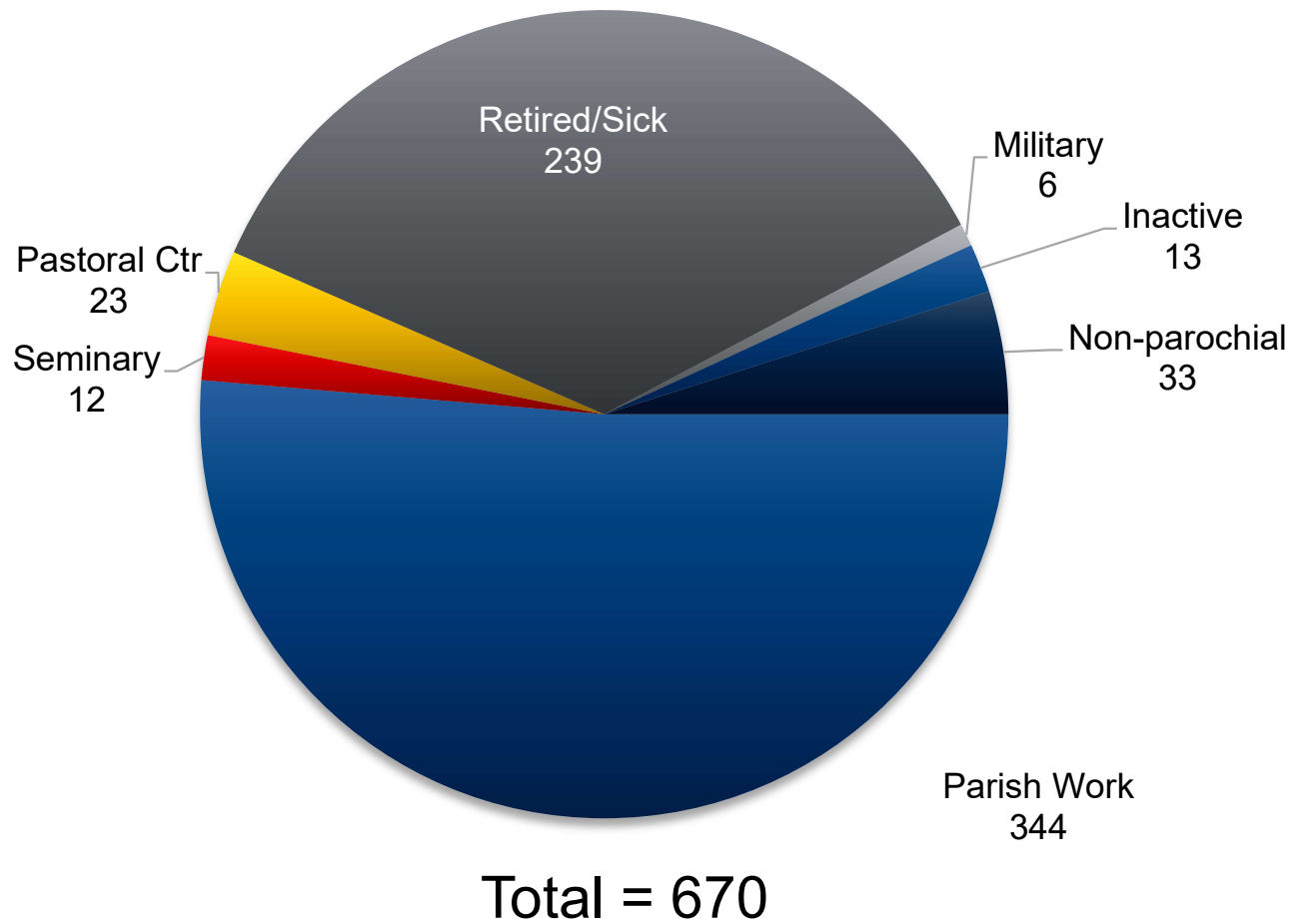

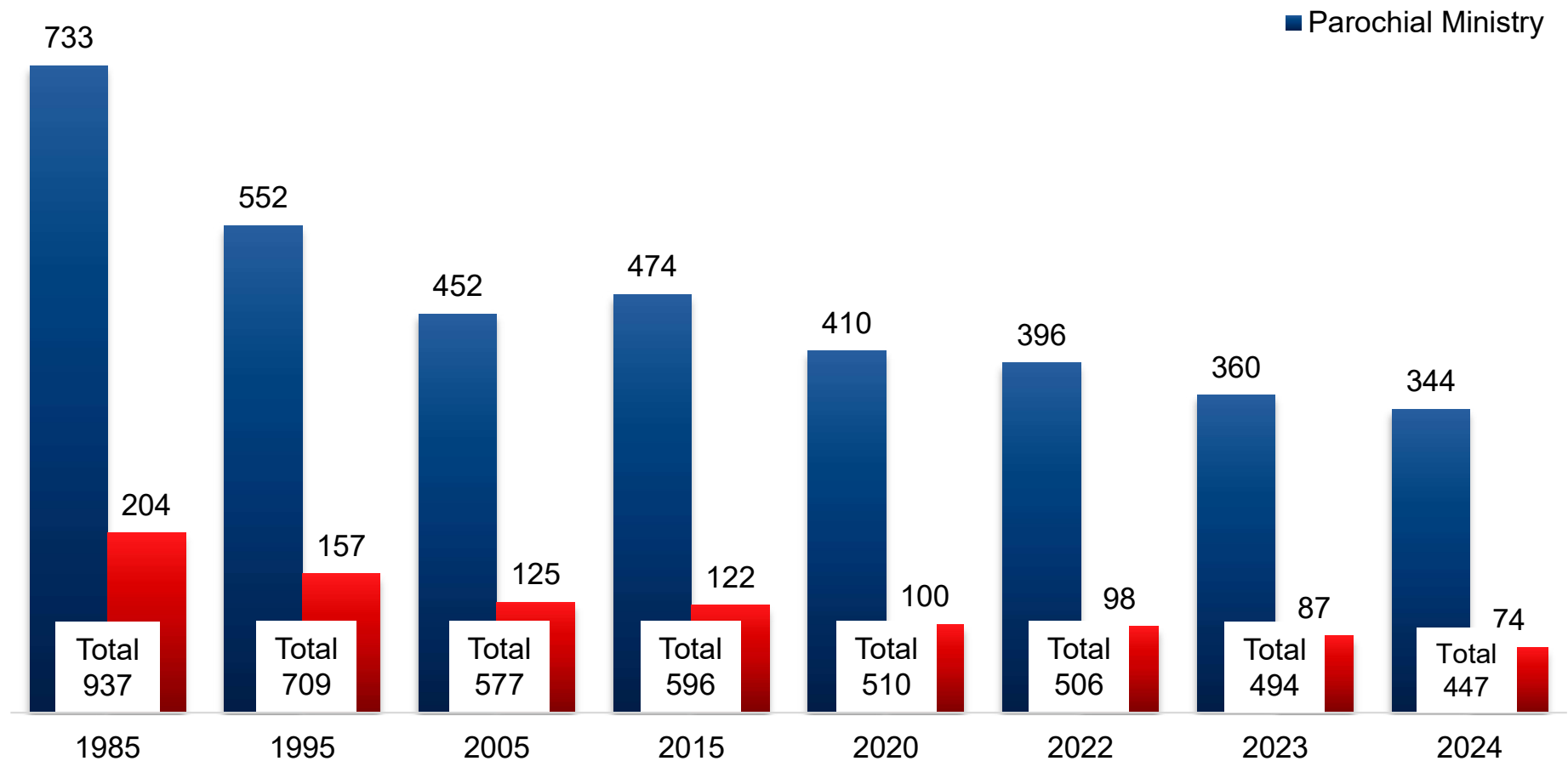
# Diocesan Priests By Category

Parochial, Other Ministries, and Retired as of January 2024

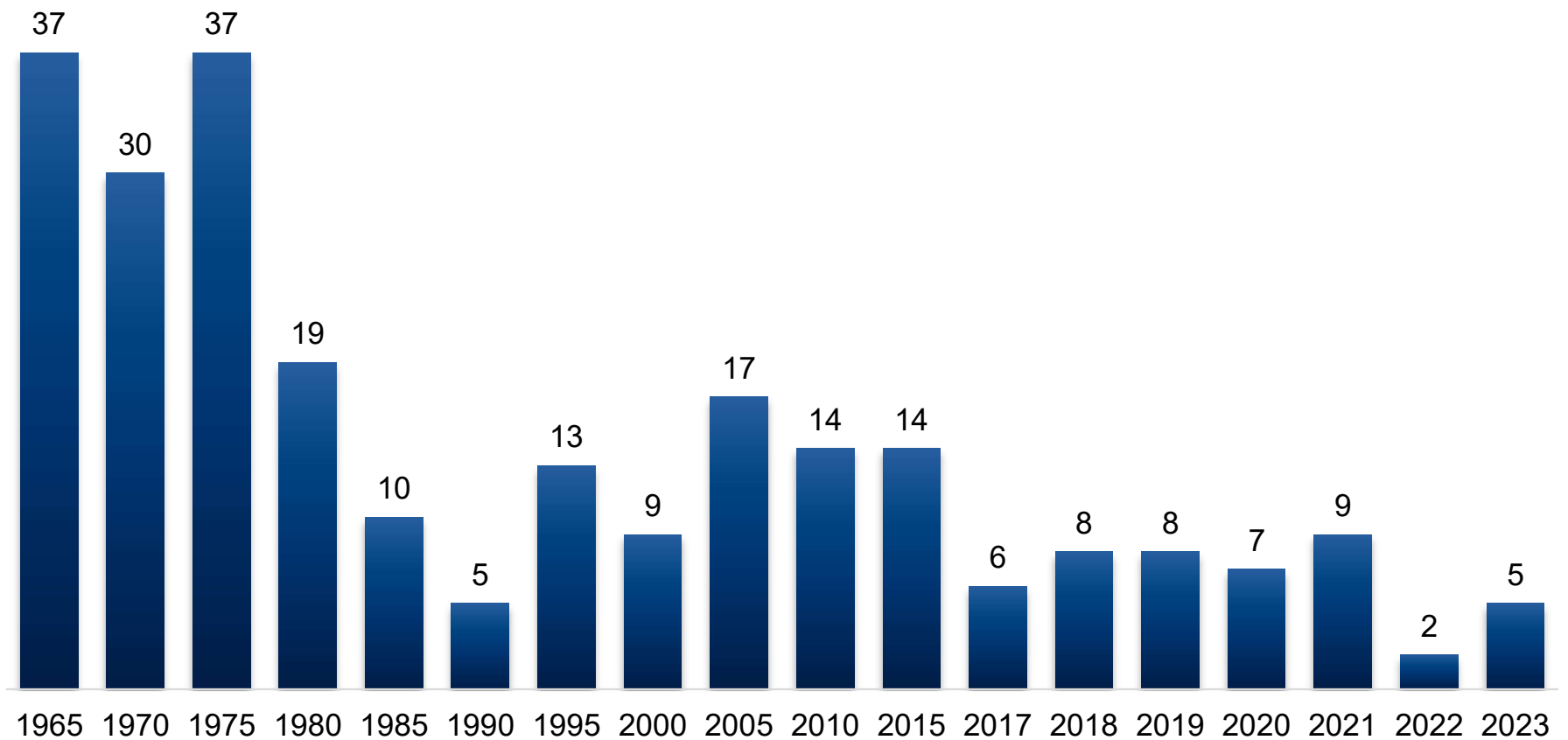

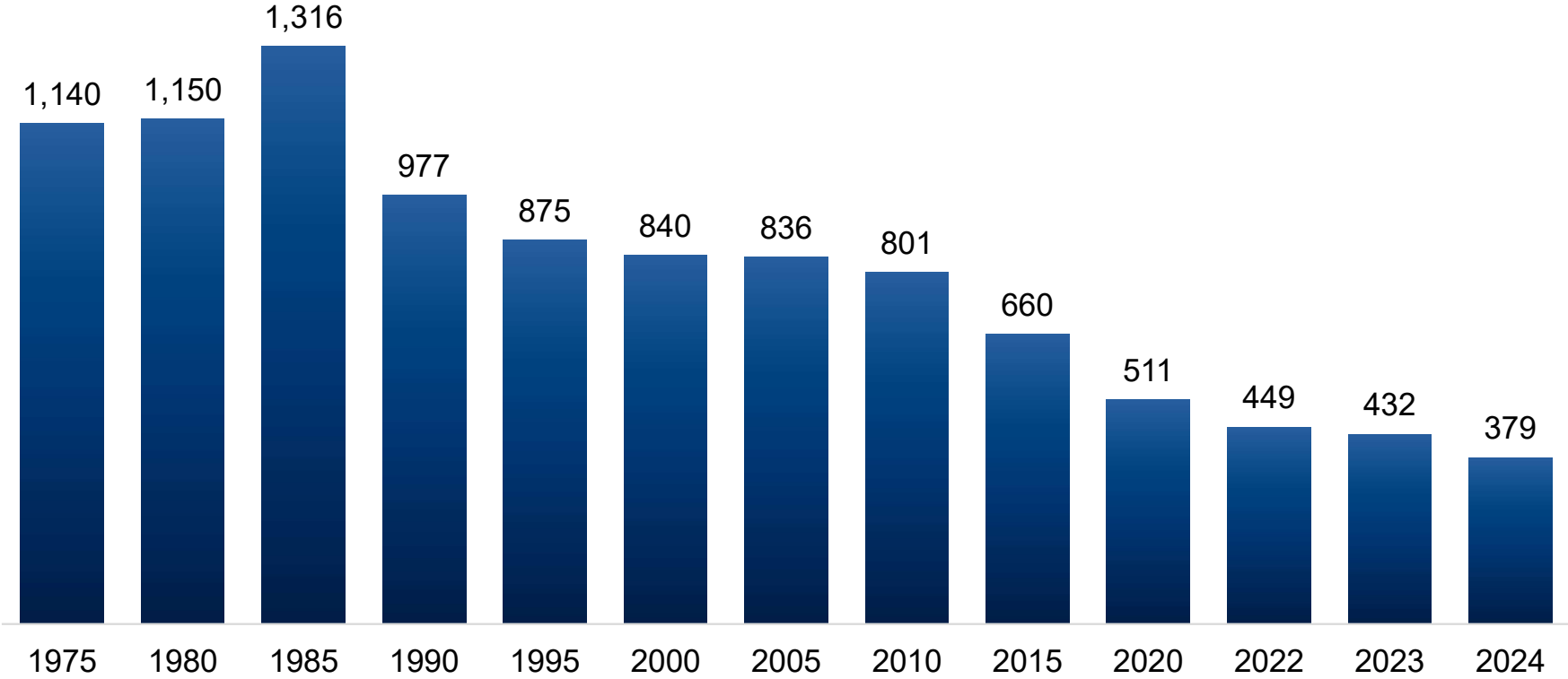

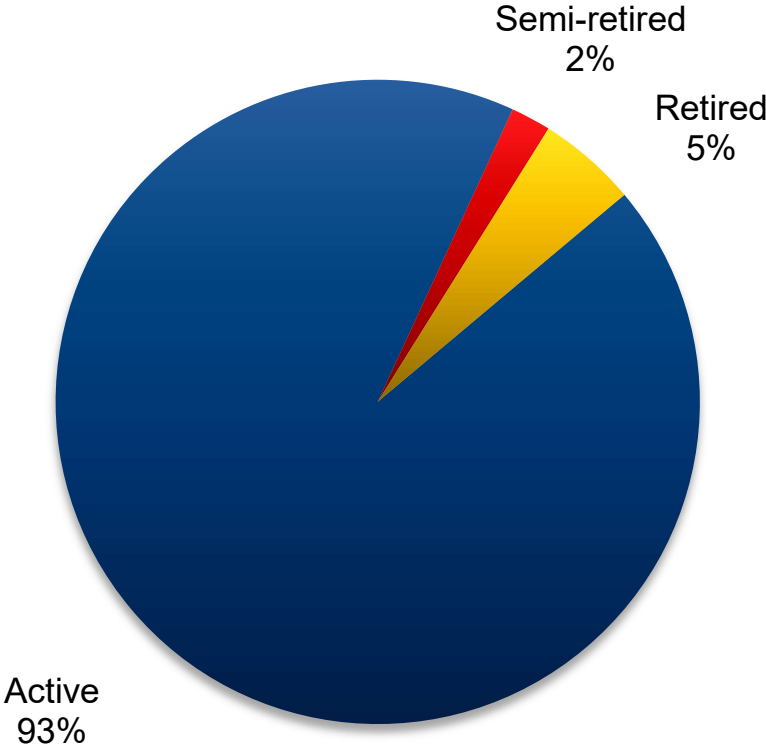

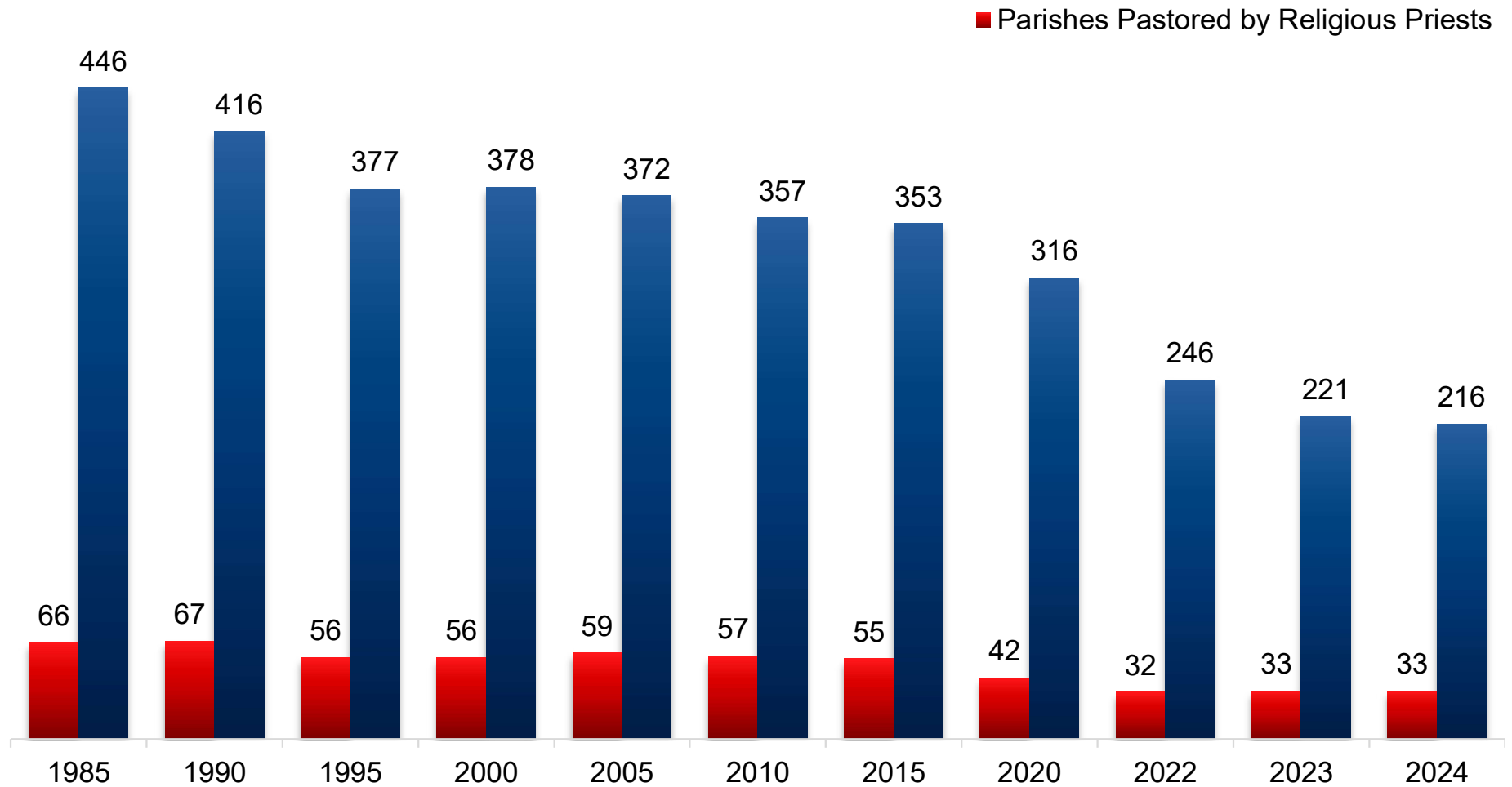

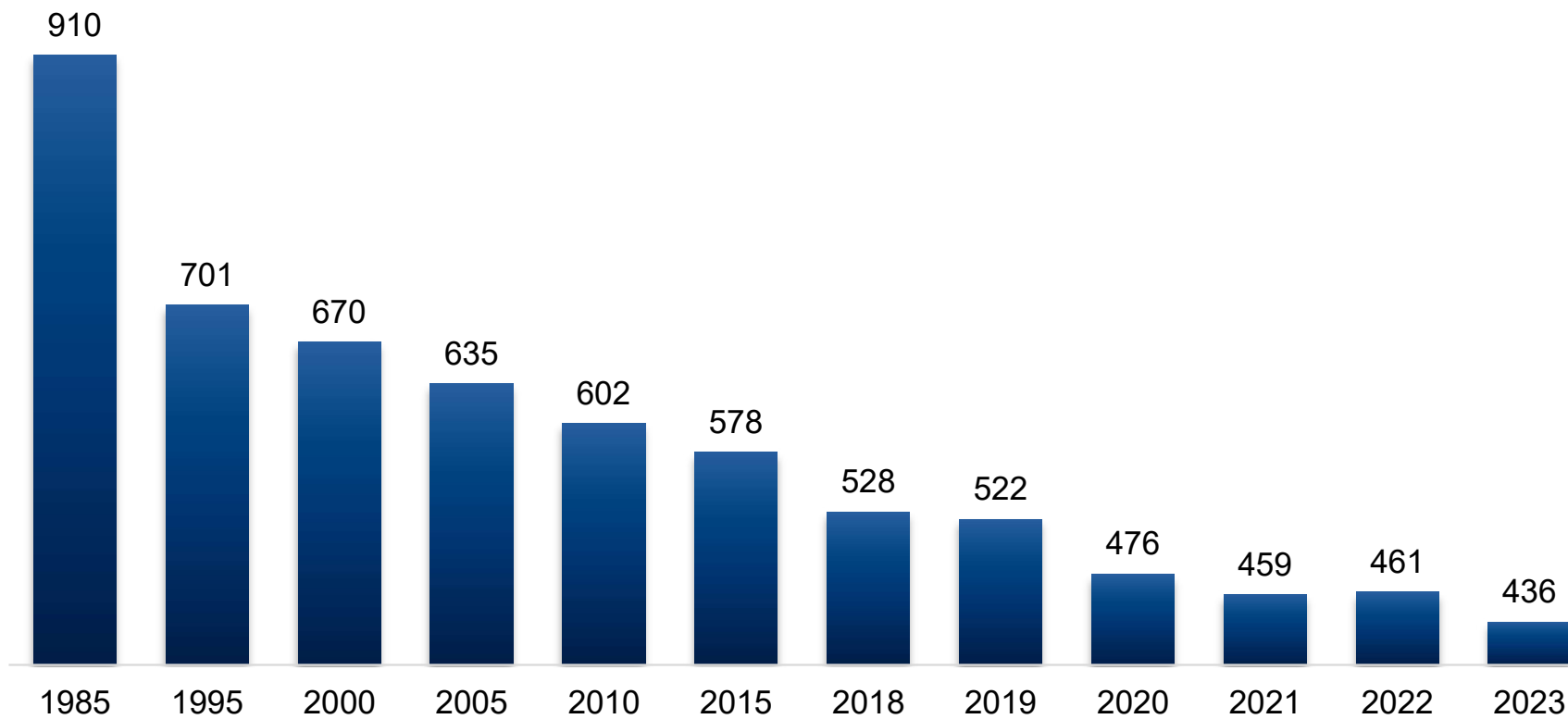

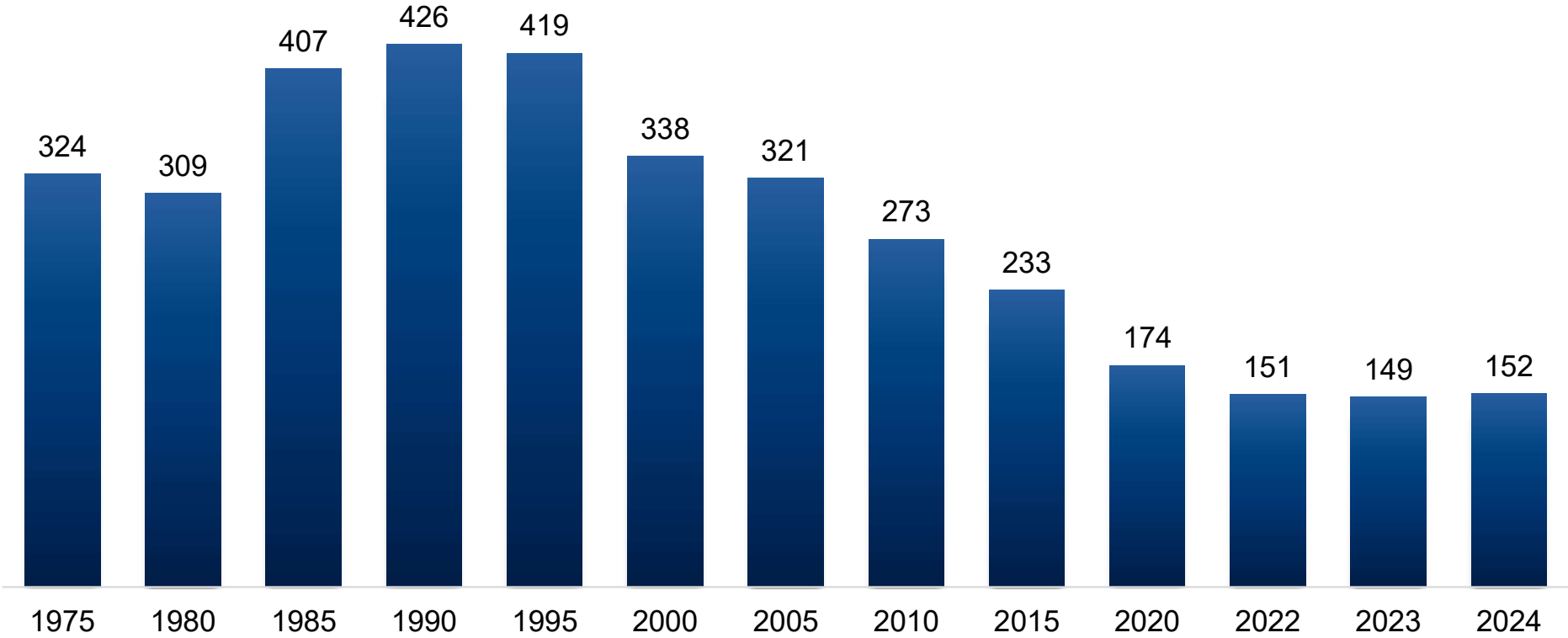

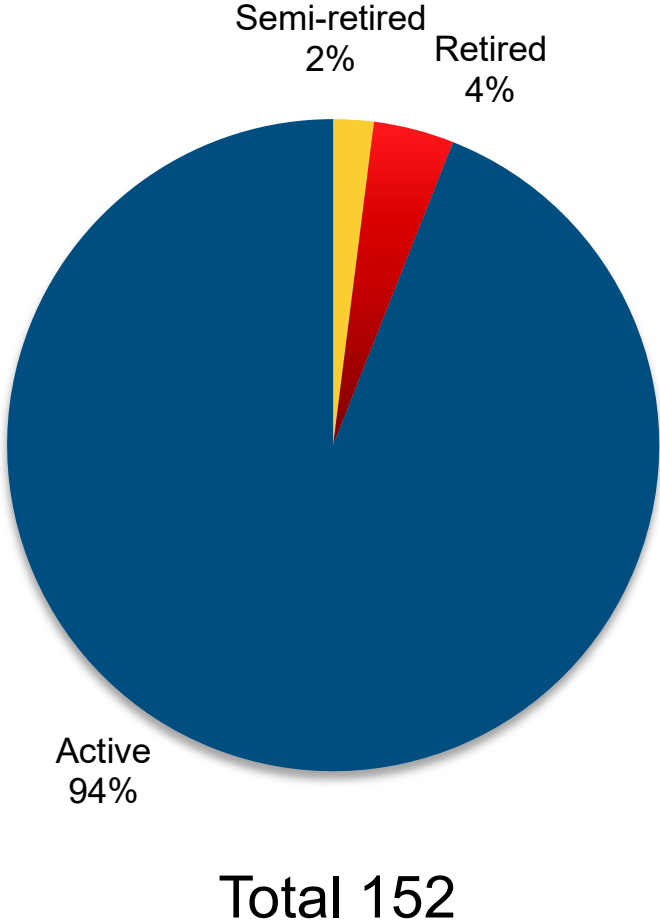

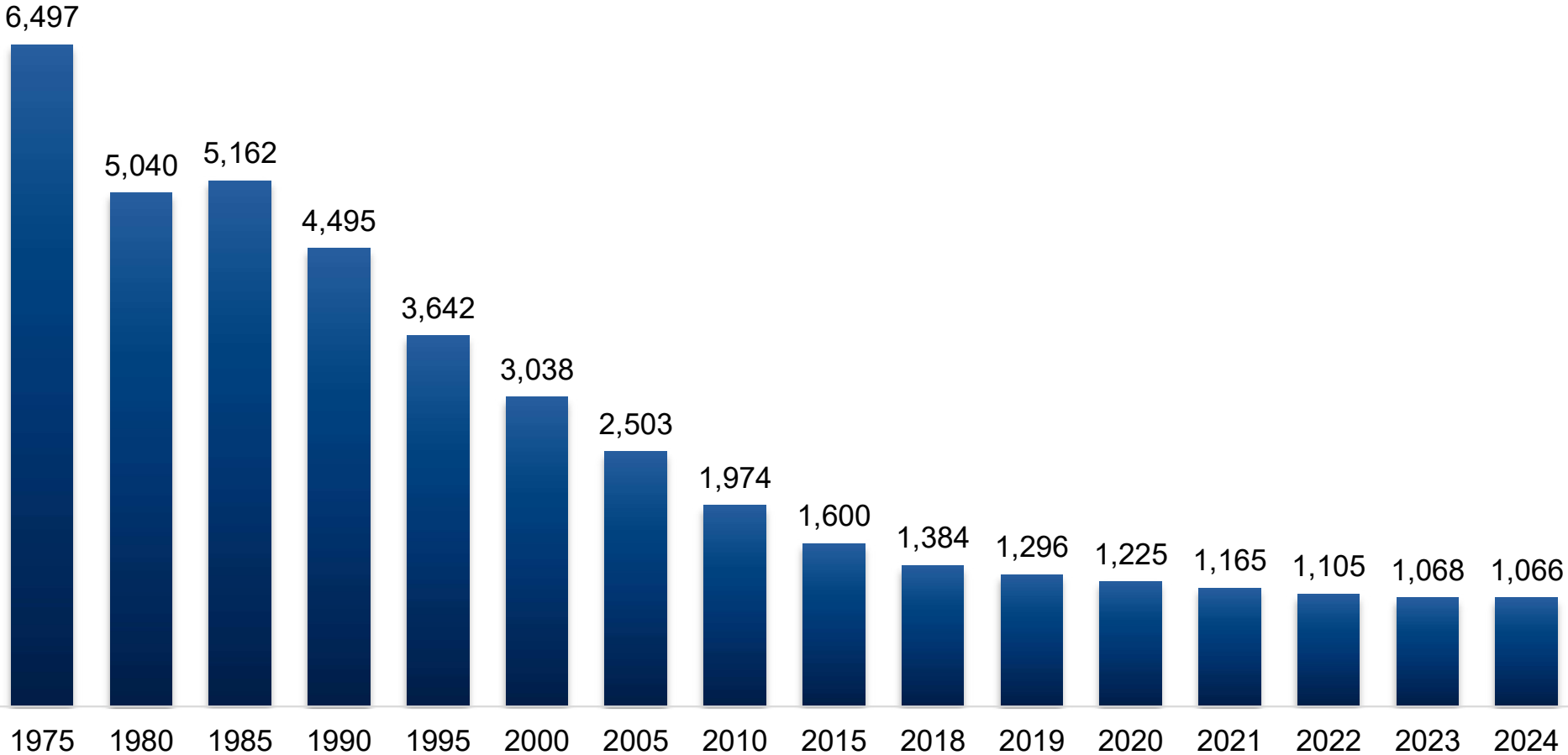
# Current Status of Religious Brothers - Total Archdiocese

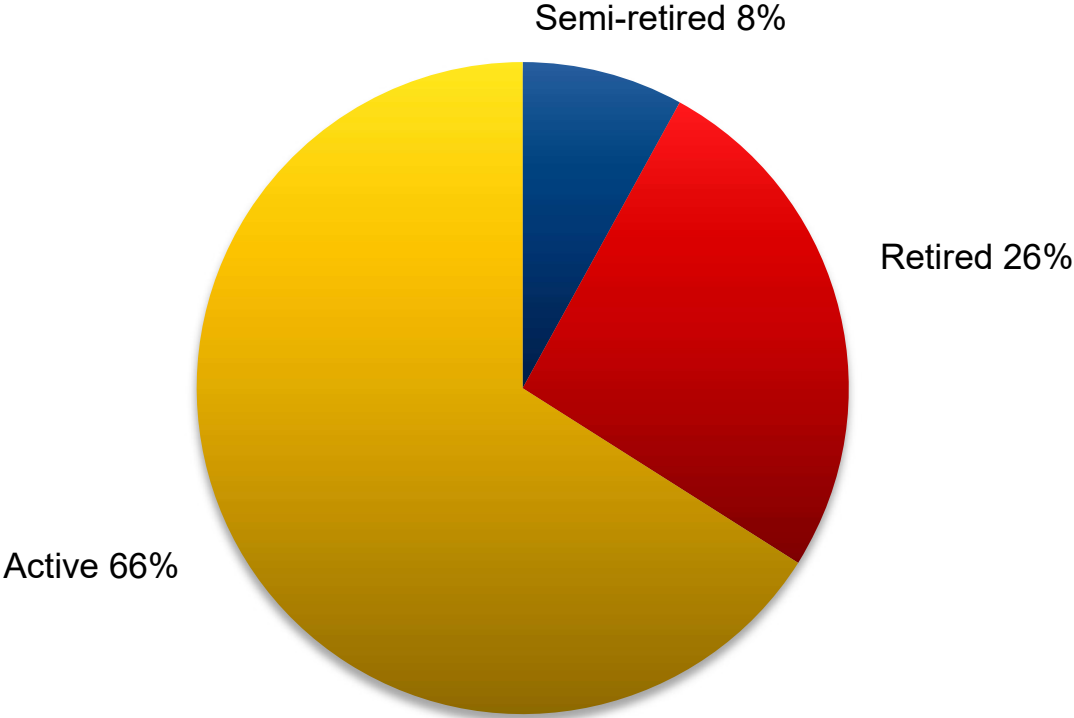

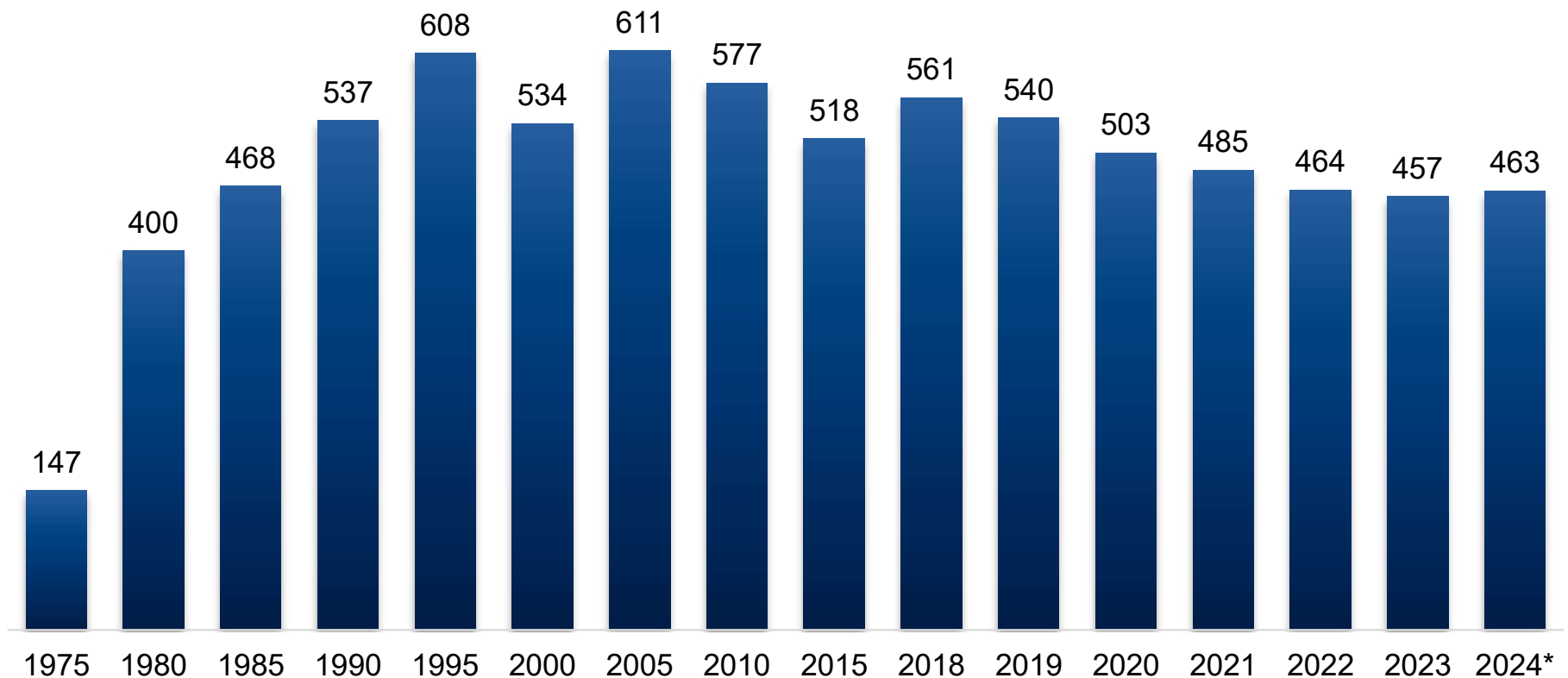

Deacons minister in over 270 Parishes, Agencies, Hospitals and Prisons

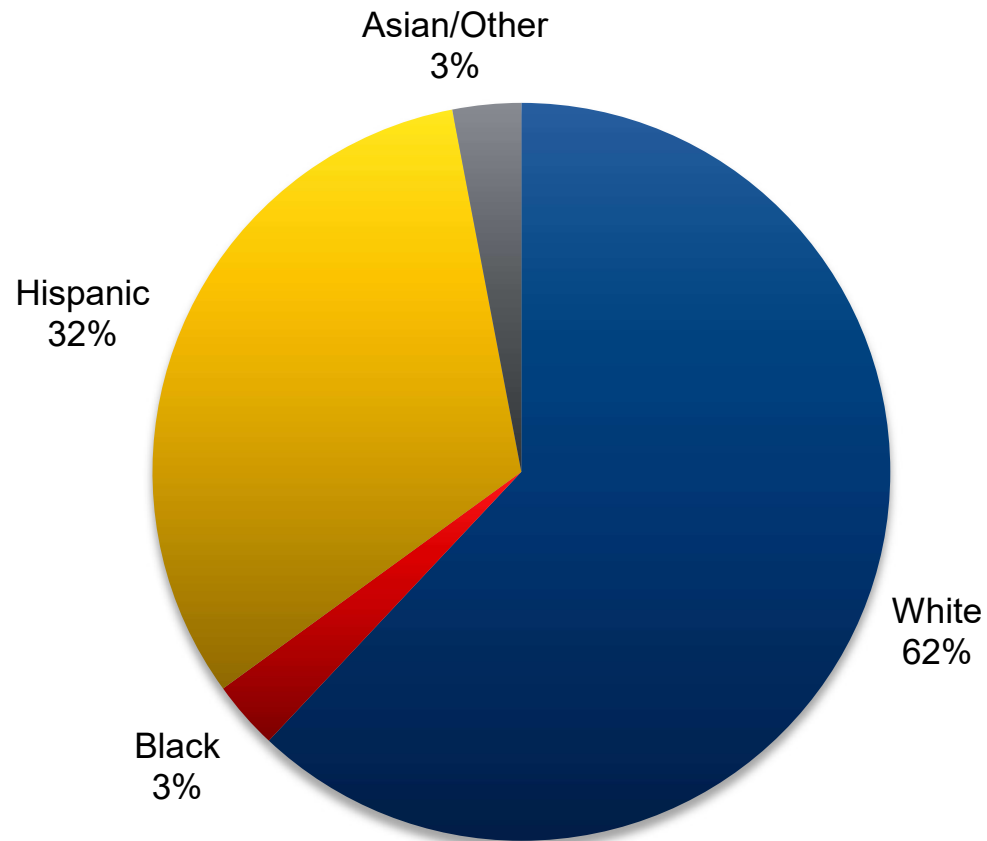

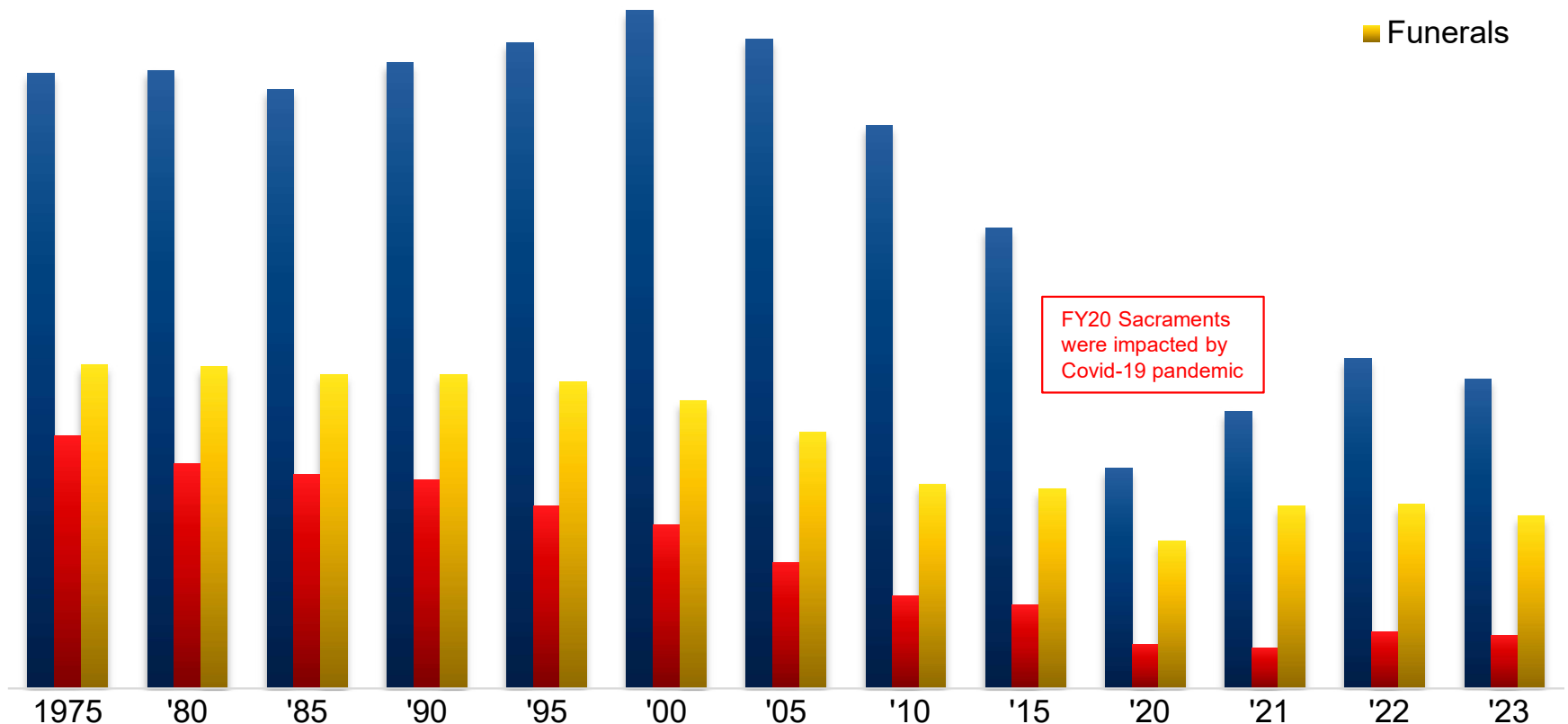

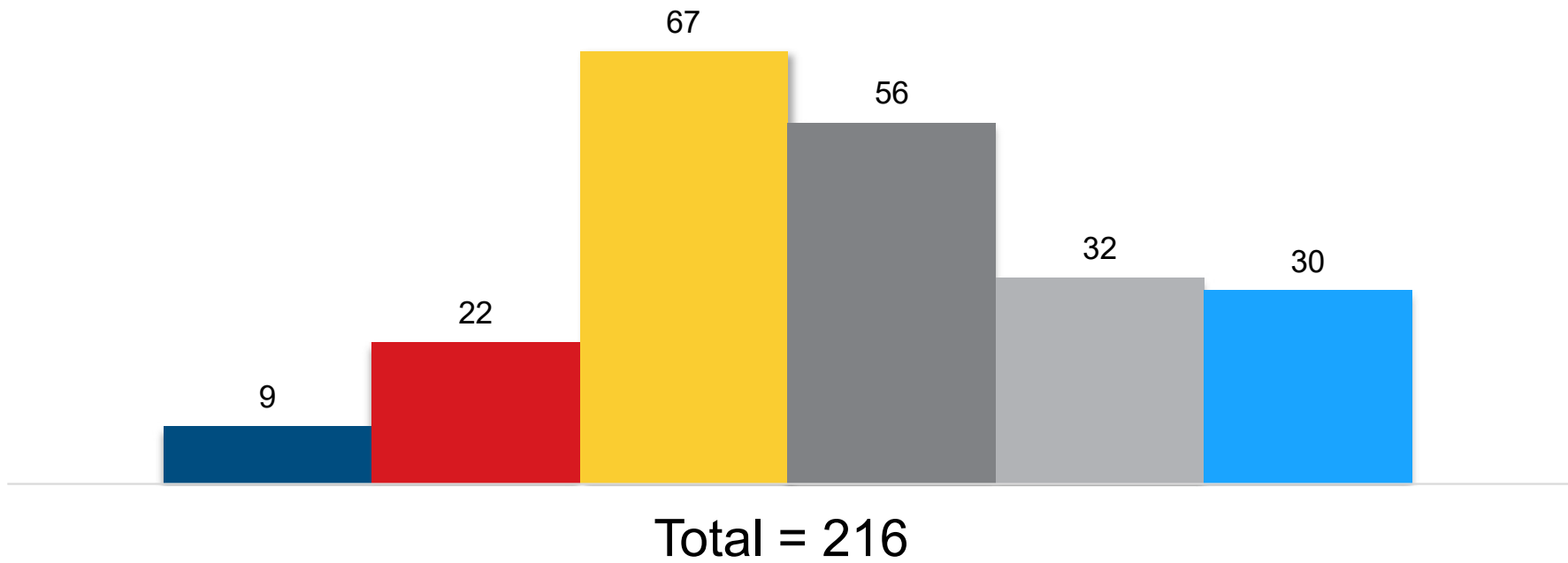

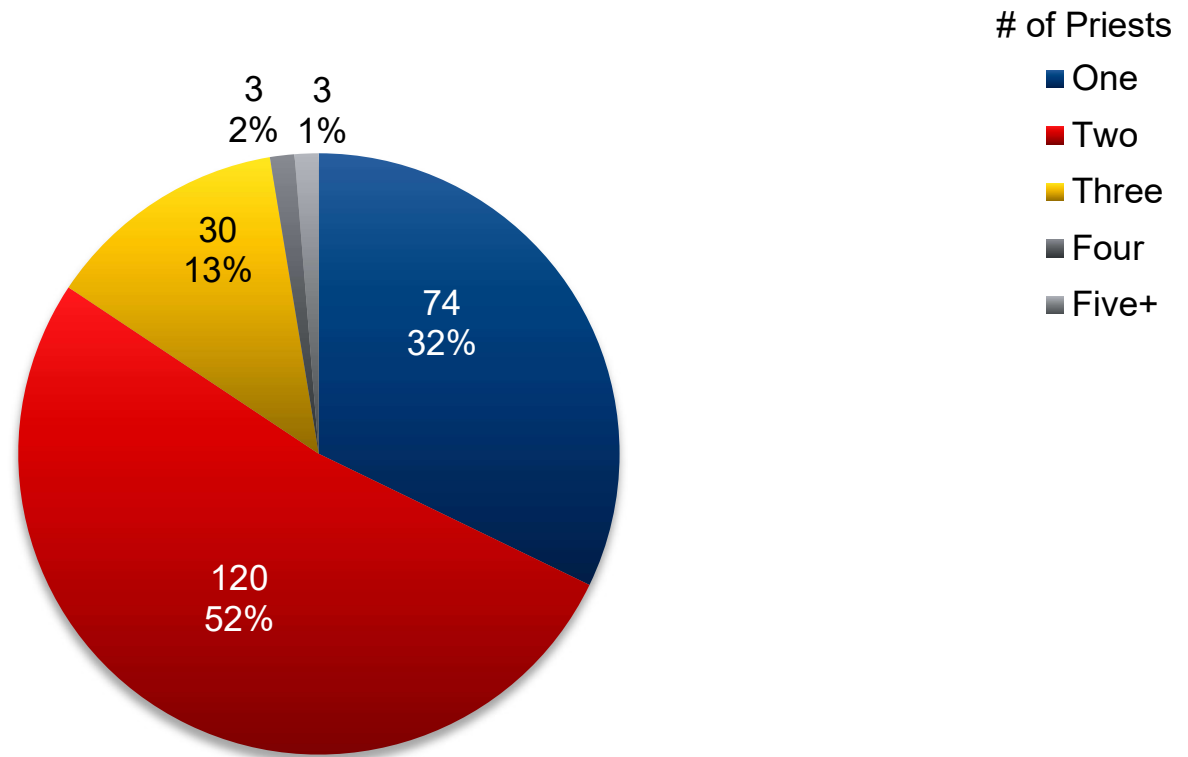

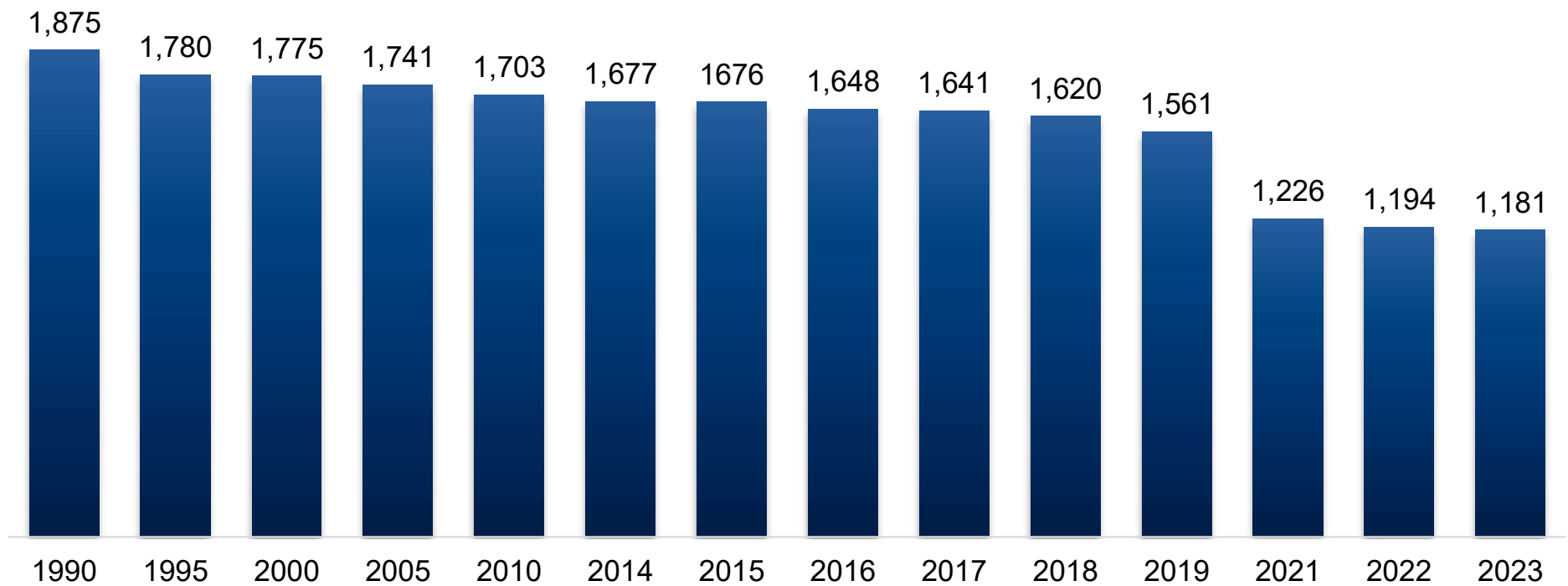

# Number of Scheduled Masses in Parishes/Missions

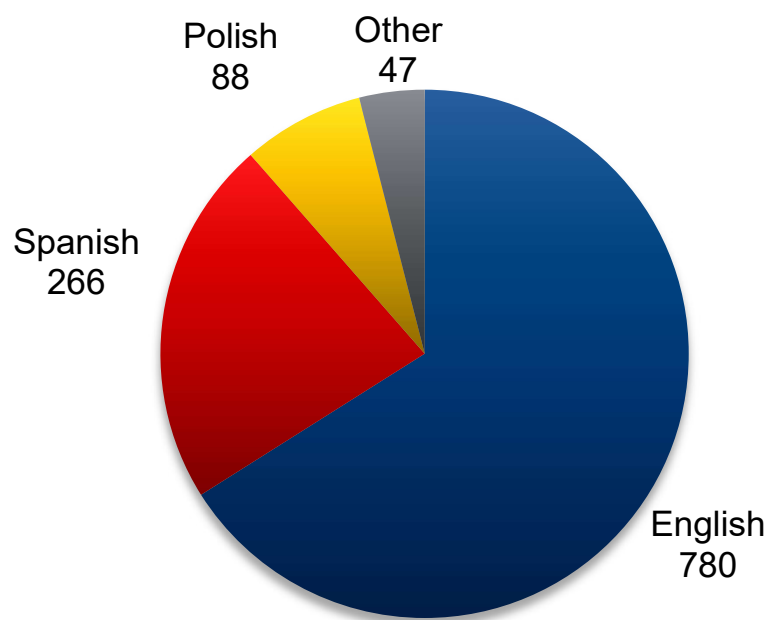

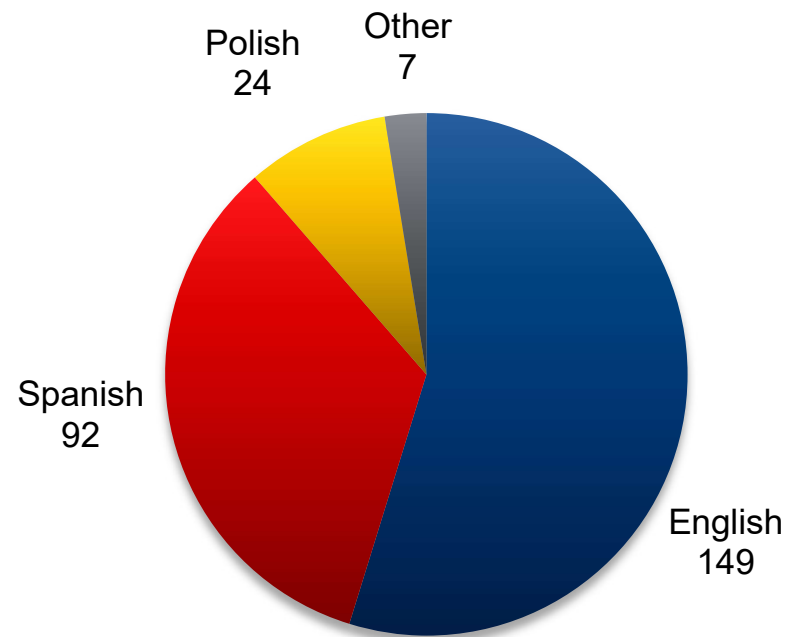


# Masses and Attendance by Language - 2023

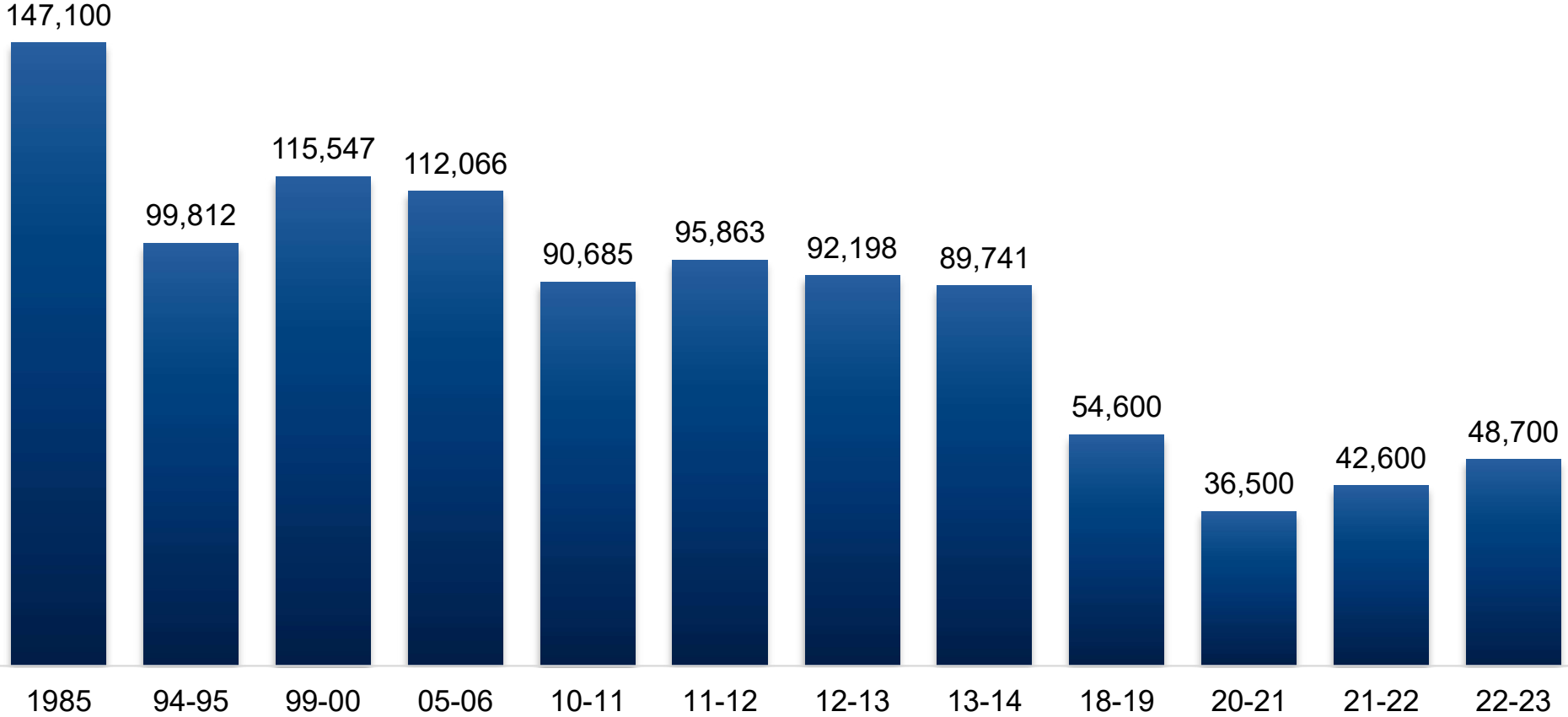

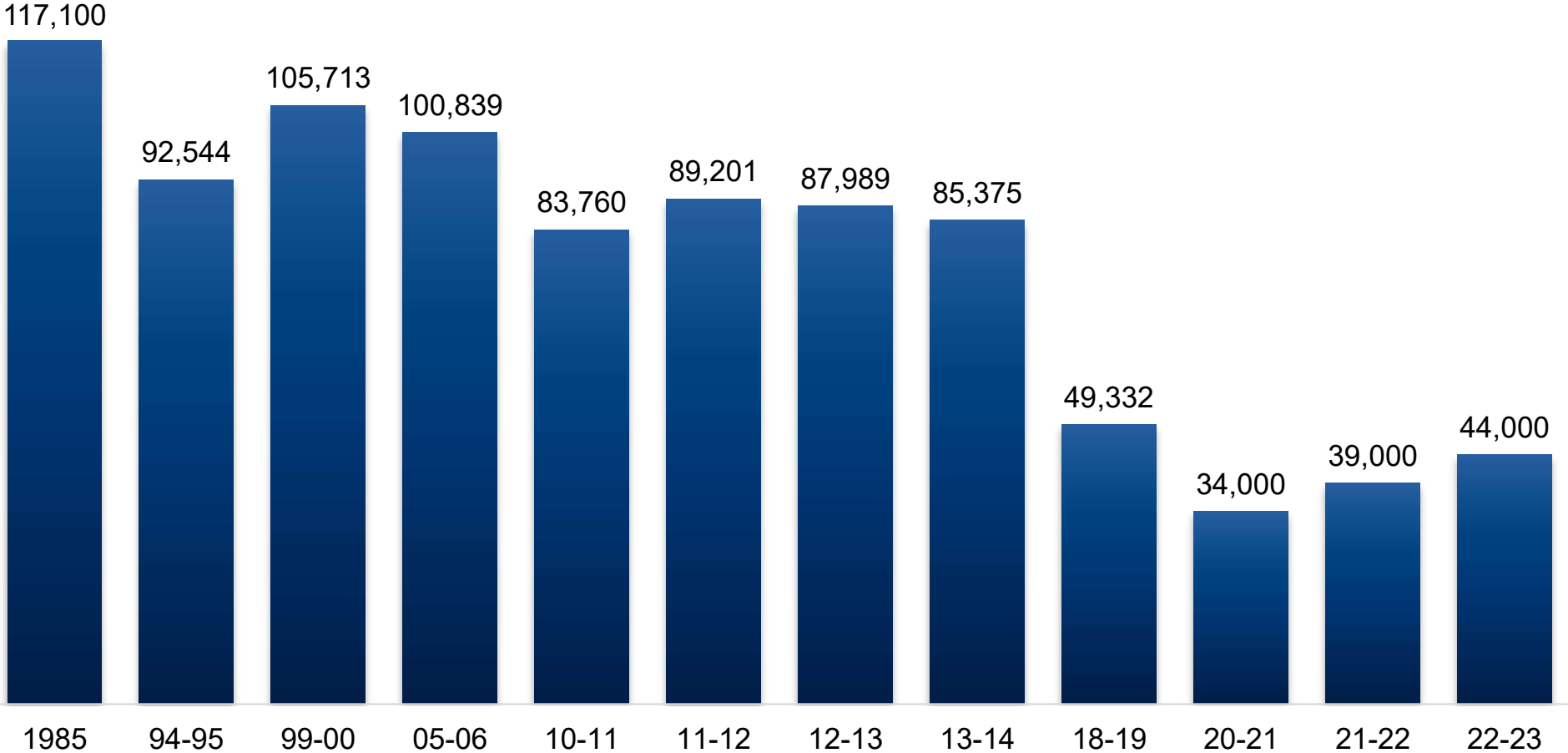

Change from 1985 to 2023

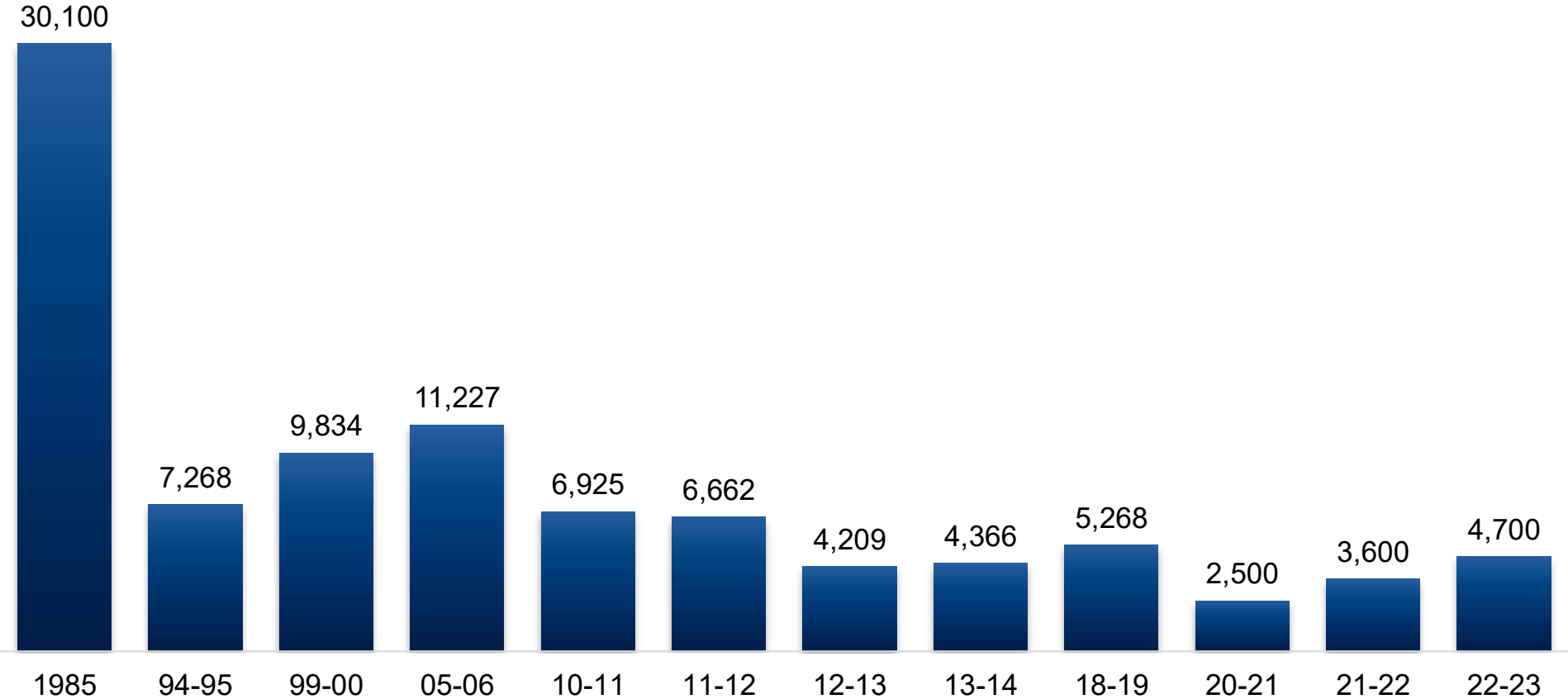

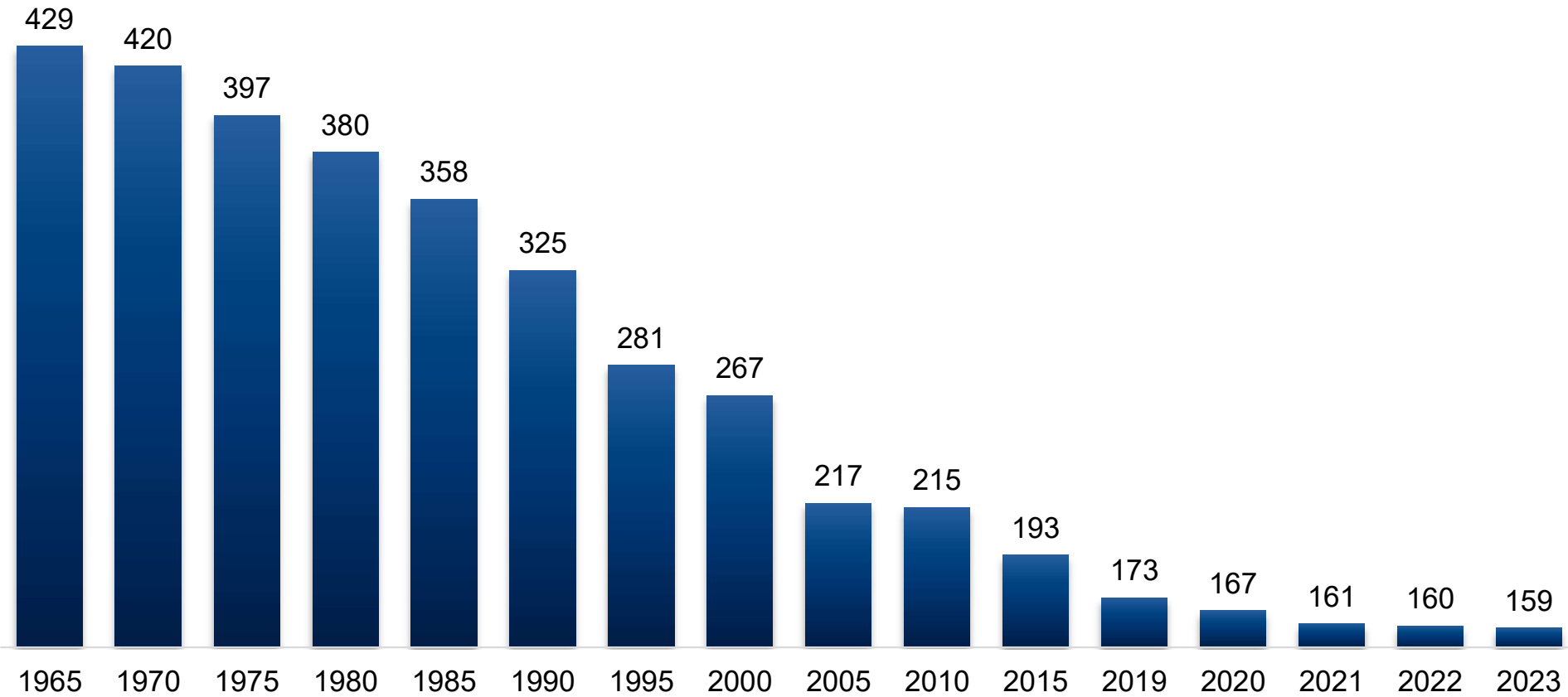

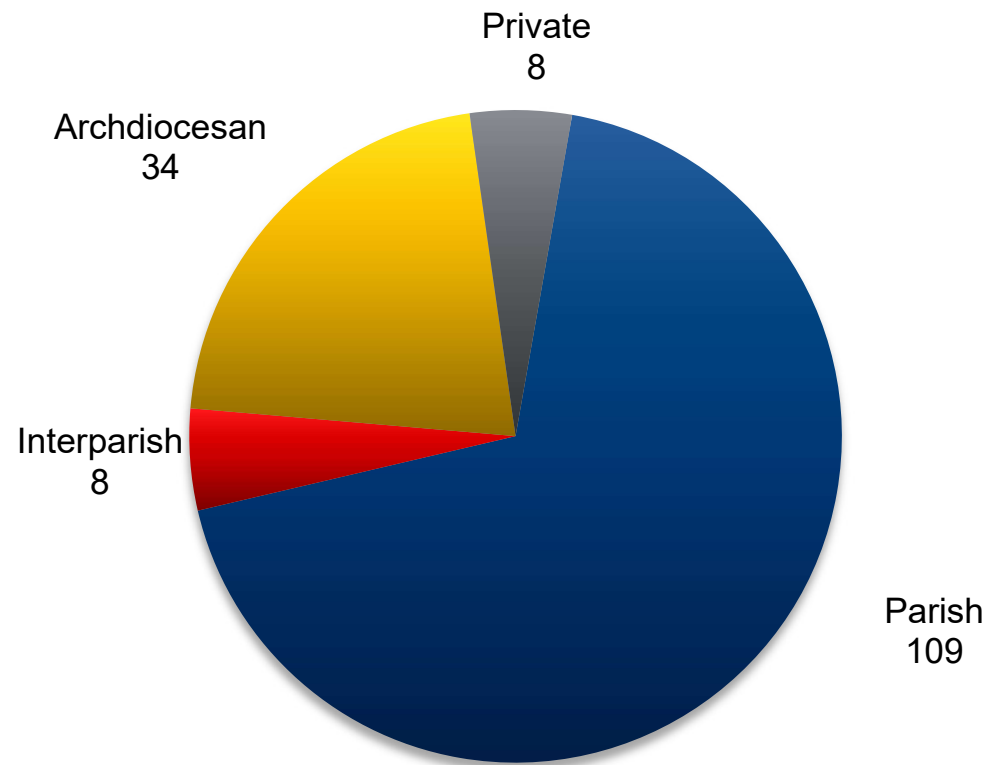
# Number of Elementary Schools in Archdiocese

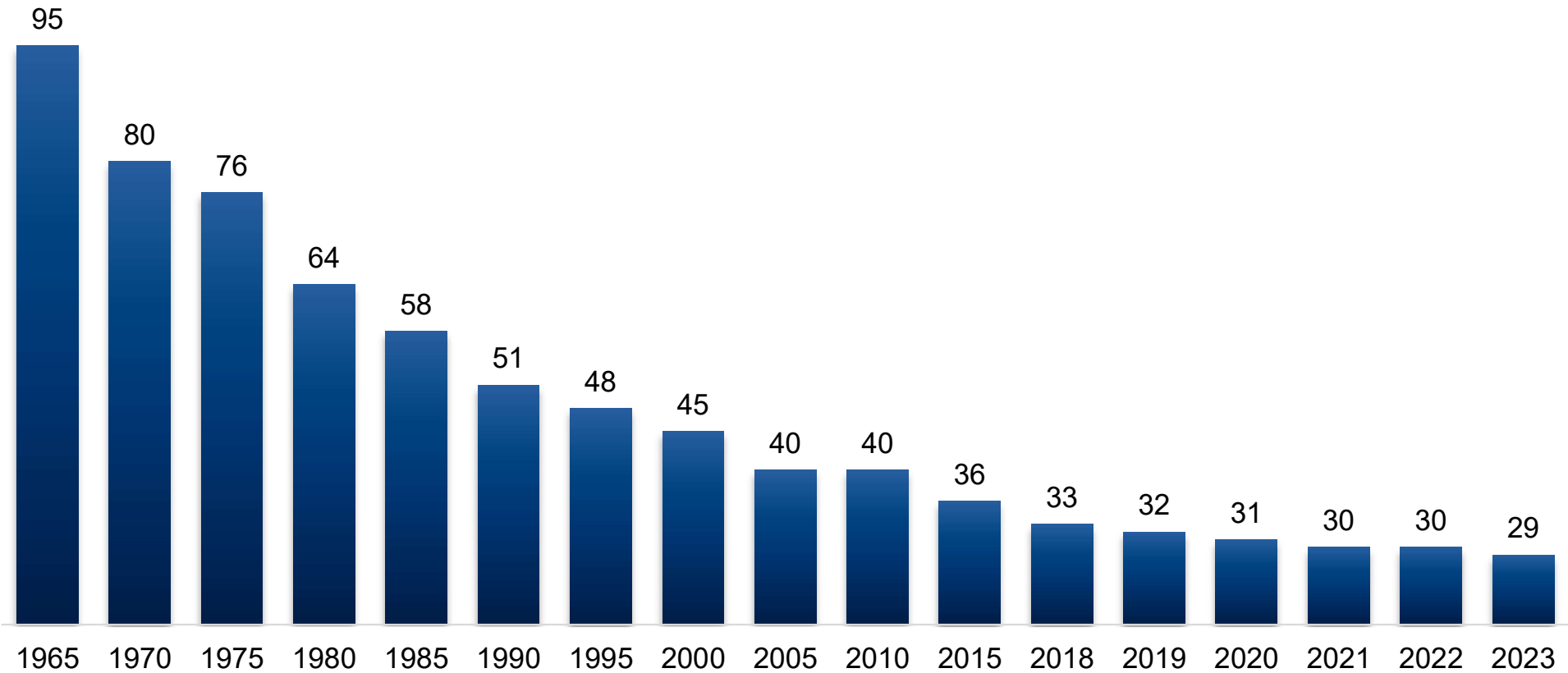

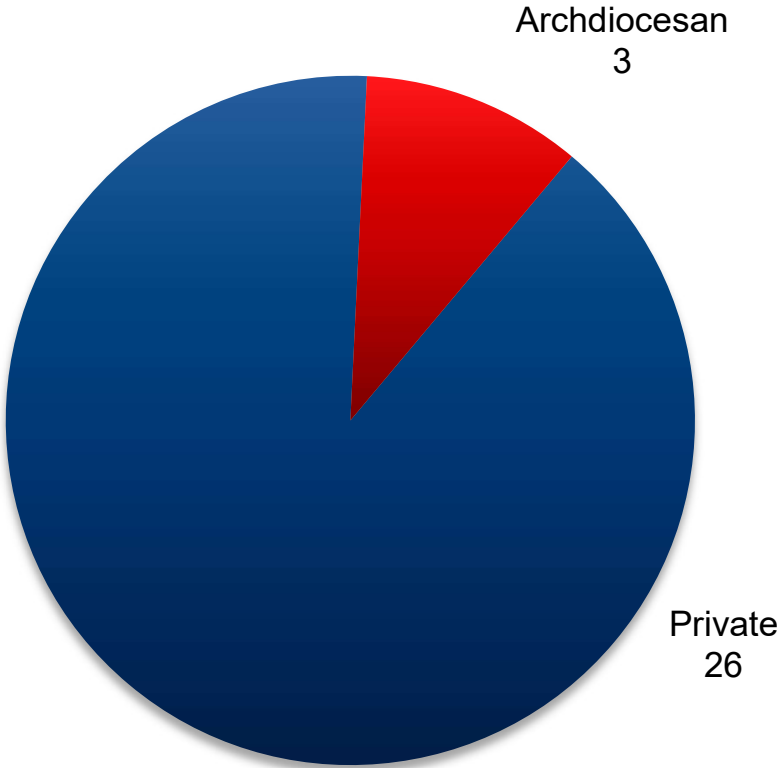
# Number of Secondary Schools in Archdiocese
